NOTIFICATION

With a view to maintain public order, peace and tranquility in the twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad, I, M. Mahendar Reddy, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, in exercise of the powers vested in me under section 22(1) (a) to (f) and 22 (2) (a) and (b) of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli (No.IX), do hereby issue the following prohibitory orders.

- I Prohibit to hold any kind of public meetings, and processions within the Hyderabad City, without obtaining prior permission of Zonal Dy. Commissioners of Police, Law and Order concerned, Addl. Commissioner of Police, Law and Order or Jt. Commissioner of Police, Co-ordination & Security or Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad.
 - a) Prohibit carrying of arms such as swords, spears, knives, sticks with or without flags bludgeons, guns, explosives, and other offensive weapons in the above mentioned areas.
 - b) Prohibit gathering of persons on the public roads or public places disturbing peace and order or causing inconvenience, annoyance or danger to public.
 - c) Prohibit collection, carrying of stones or other means of casting missiles.
- II Prohibit use of mikes/public address system by different Organisations around the Secretariat premises, including Burgula Rama Krishna Rao Building, Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation Building, Commissioner of Fisheries building, Mint Compound, Nizam College and its surroundings, Telangana / A.P. Legislative Assembly premises and surrounding roads, Public Garden Nampally, Upper Tankbund, I-MAX, Rotary and NTR Marg roads also fly-over road leading from Secretariat to Visweswarayya statue, Khairatabad.
 - a) Prohibit music, singing or speeches or broadcasting through loud speakers in the above mentioned areas.
 - b) Prohibit use of mikes/public address systems, use of horn through vehicles by any organisation, members of public etc., in the above mentioned areas.
- III The public are here by informed that any person violating the above orders shall be liable for prosecution under the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348, Fasli (No. IX).
- IV **The following are exempted from the operation of this order**
 - (i) Police Officers on duty,
 - (ii) Military personnel on duty,
 - (iii) Home Guards on duty,
 - (iv) Bonafide funeral processions.

This order shall be in force with effect from 0600 hours on 22-04-2017 to 0600 hours on 28-04-2017.

THE MYSTERY BEHIND HOAX MAIL SOLVED –ONE HELD

On 20-04-2017, the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone team with the assistance of S.R Nagar police, on credible information made sustained efforts and solved the mystery behind hoax mail which was generated from Hyderabad.

Details of apprehended Accused :-

Motaparthi Vamshi Krishna @ vamshi chowdary S/o. M.A.sV. Prasad, age. 32 yrs, Occ. Transport agent R/o. Flat no.G-1, TP Sanjana Amrutha Residency, Miyapur, R.R.Dist, N/o. Dendullur (village & Mandal), West Godavari Dist, A.P.

Brief facts

On 15-04-2017 at 1647 hours commissioner of police, Mumbai received a mail from a mail ID ununn0801@gmail.com claimed to be woman in the email and stated that she overheard six men chatting in a hotel and stating that all 23 people have to split from here and board flights in three cities i.e Hyderabad, Chennai and Mumbai to hijack planes at a time tomorrow.

On the tip of Mumbai Police alerted and sent the information to the concerned Airport Security agencies about a gang planning to hijack flights from three Airports.

Basing on the information CISF pressed into service and quick reaction commando teams under taken sanitisation drill at Airport and Airlines have been asked to remain extra vigilant. Extra care has been given to passenger checks, baggage scanning, pre embarkation checks and started special patrols to thwart any bid to storm the Airport.

As a mail generated from Hyderabad, considering the seriousness and sensitivity of the issue, the Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad instructed the Task Force team to check the veracity of the mail.

During the enquiry traced the IP address and found it is a net cafe at Madhura Nagar, S.R.Nagar styled as "E netzone" and enquired with the owner of net cafe and found the register of the visitors and filtered eight persons at the time of generating mail. Since the net cafe did not have CCTV footages and there were no proper records maintained at net cafe centre, The Task Force Police made sustained efforts based on the available of CC footage nearby net cafe and lead to the identification of accused by name Vamsi Krishna.

During the interrogation the accused revealed that he used to chat with his girlfriend who stays at Chennai. Few days back she proposed a trip to Mumbai & Goa. As he is facing financial problems, he unable to bare expanses for their tour, he requested her to withdraw the trip proposal, but she denied his request, forced him to go to trip to Mumbai & Goa. In this process to cancel the trip, he hatched a plan to make her believe that flights have been cancelled because of High Alert at airports.

In this connection he created a fake flight booking Ticket on her name dt. 16-04-2017 from Chennai to Mumbai, sent the fake ticket to his girl friend through his mail Id my3softcreations@gmail.com to her mail id on 15-04-2017 to believe her. If she knows about the fake ticket, she will avoid him. On that he went to one internet centre styled as "E Net zone" at Madhura Nagar, SR.Nagar on 15-04-2017 at about 1600 hrs. In this net zone he created a fake mail id "ununn0801@gamil.com" and secured the Mail Ids of Mumbai police commissioner and others and prepared fake message as "hi sir am female here am doing this mail frim Hyderabad as i don't want to revel my details couse am a female and scared of issues, and mailing u this couse in the after noon around 2pm while having lunch there were 6 guys talking those guys are musclims, they were talking abt plane hijack tommarrow in Hyderabad chennai and Mumbai airport they were talking very slowly but unfortunately i heard few conversations abt this, they were saying all us 23 people have to split from here and have to board flights in 3 cities and hijack them at a time. They spoke some other things also but i couls not hear them as i heard only these few sentences from them, i dont know do am i doing

correct or not and they are true or not but heard this so kindly go through this and as i informed this as a duty and a citizen of india and pls dont make me to get into issues”

On further questioning he revealed that previously he was involved in two cases Cr.No. 411/2010, U/s. 420, 458,506 R/w. 34 IPC of S.R.Nagar PS & Cr.No. 32/2013, U/s. 66(D) of ITA Act-2008 & 420 IPC of CCS, Cyber crimes.

The apprehended accused along with seized material being handover to SHO, S.R.Nagar PS for taking further action under 66D of IT act and sec 419, 182 IPC.

NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, reports have been received indicating that consumption of liquor in public places has become rampant and unhindered in several areas of the City of Hyderabad, resulting in to a menace to the common members of the public, especially women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, such reports have been indicating that, persons consuming liquor in public places have been exhibiting abrasive unruly and indecent behavior on the streets of Hyderabad City towards law abiding citizens especially women and children in particular endangering their modesty and safety in addition to causing disturbance to public tranquility resulting in annoyance and obstruction to road users in general and women and children in particular.

WHEREAS, such unruly and indecent behavior has been instilling a sense of fear psychosis in law abiding citizens, especially women and children resulting in restriction of their free movement on the streets of Hyderabad, thereby affecting public safety at large and safety and security of women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, it is considered necessary to take speedy measures in this regard to prevent danger to human life and safety and security of women and children or for preventing any affray and disturbance of public tranquillity.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 144 of Criminal Procedure Code 1973, I, M. Mahendar Reddy, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the General Public **prohibiting Consumption of liquor in public places in the City of Hyderabad.**

This order is published for the information of public through the media and through the public address system in the areas affected with drunkenness in public places.

This order shall come into force from 0600 hours on 21-04-2017 and shall remain in force for a period of one week i.e. upto 0600 hours on 27-04-2017 (both days inclusive) unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment under Section 188 of the Indian Penal code and as per the provisions of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

FOUR MEMBERS GANJA SUMMGLING GANG HELD,
SEIZED 100 KGs of GANJA.

On 20.04.2017, the Commissioner's Task Force, East Zone Team, Hyderabad, apprehended a Ganja smuggling gang consisting of 04-members namely viz., **1) Shobha Mali, 2) Moti wale Naresh Singh, 3) Praveen Singh, and 4) Binesh Singh** along with **100 Kgs Ganja, 04-Cell Phones, One Honda Activa Bike** at Quthbiguda, Chappal Bazar, Kachiguda, Hyderabad.

Brief Facts:-

Acting on a tip off, the Commissioners Task Force, East Zone Team, Hyderabad, apprehended 04-persons who have been supplying and selling Ganja and seized 100 KGs of Ganja, 04-Cell phones, and one Bike from their possession.

During interrogation the prime accused Mali Shoba confessed that she is a native of Sholapur, Maharashtra State, and after getting marriage with one Santhosh of Hyderabad, about 18 years back she settled in Kachiguda, Hyderabad. Her husband does not attend any work so she intend to earn money. One Mukesh Singh, (who is involved in criminal cases while he was supplying Ganja to the customers) resident of Dhoolpet is her family friend and while he was in the act of illegal supply of Ganja to the customers, the prime accused Shobha thought of doing the same business to earn easy money. After that she came into contact with suppliers of Ganja of Nalgonda District, and started procuring Ganja at huge quantity from them, store the same at her house and used to supply the same to the needy customers clandestinely and getting high margins. According to the suggestion of one of her customers namely Naresh of Dhoolpet, she took one godown in Quthbiguda, Chappal Bazar, Kachiguda, Hyderabad about two months back for rent of Rs.3,000/- per month with an intention to store the Ganja in the godown.

She regularly used to supply the Ganja to Naresh Singh and others. Sometimes Naresh sends his persons to her to purchase Ganja at her godown.

Accused Shobha used to purchase Ganja from her source at Rs.3,000/- per KG and sell at high price. During enquiry it is learnt that the accused persons have been getting the contraband Ganja from the agency area of North coastal of A.P. State through the agents of Nalgonda District. Today i.e., on 20-04-2017 in the morning when she was supplying Ganja to Naresh and

two of his associates namely Praveen Singh and Binesh Singh at her godown, the Task Force, East Zone Team organized a raid at the godown of Shobha situated in Quthbiguda, Chappal Bazar, Kachiguda, Hyderabad apprehended the above said four accused persons and seized 100 Kgs of Ganja, 04-Cell Phones, One Bike and other incriminating material from them.

The above accused persons and seized property are being handed over to the Police Kachiguda, Hyderabad for further investigation.

The above arrests were made under the supervision of **Sri N.Koti Reddy, Addl. Dy. Commissioner of Police, Commissioner's Task Force, Hyderabad**, by **Sri S. Mohan Kumar, Inspector of Police, Commissioner's Task Force, East Zone, Hyderabad**, and SI's S/Sri A.Sudhakar, K.Srinivas, S.Saida Babu and the staff of the Commissioner's Task Force, East Zone Team, Hyderabad.
