NOTIFICATION

With a view to maintain public order, peace and tranquility in the area known as Andhra Pradesh and Telangana Secretariats, Hyderabad in the limits of Saifabad Police Station, together with the offices located within the premises of the Telangana and A.P. Secretariats including the gates leading to the offices and also areas falling upto a distance of 3 KM s from secretariat building perimeter, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, in exercise of the powers vested in me under Sec 22 of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the general public prohibiting the following matters :-

- i) holding of any public meeting;
- ii) Assembly of five or more persons;
- iii) Carrying the fire arms, banners, placards, lathis, spears, swords, sticks, brickbats, etc;
- iv) Shouting of slogans;
- v) Making of speeches, etc;
- vi) Processions and demonstration; and
- vii) Picketing or dharnas within the area specified in the schedule to this order without a written permission.

As the order cannot be served practicably on each individual and all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte and the same is published for the information of general public through press and by affixing copies of this order on the notice boards of the offices of all the DCsP, ACsP and all Police Stations concerned and other places for conveying the information to the general public.

This order shall be in force with effect from 0600 hours on 23-11.2018 and shall remain in force for a period of two months i.e. upto 0600 hours on 22-01-2019 (both days inclusive), unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating the order shall be liable for punishment under section 188 of the Indian Penal code and as per the provisions of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

**NABBED HOUSE BURGLARY GANG 04 – HELD &
RECOVERED 130-TULAS GOLD ORNAMENTS AND 1 ½ KG SILVER ITEMS WORTH
OF Rs. 40 lakhs**

On 19.11.2018, the sleuths of Sanjeeva Reddy Nagar Crime Team, West Zone Team, Hyderabad, nabbed a notorious habitual Burglary gang consisting of 04-accused namely viz., **A-1 Shamshad @ Bhura, A-2 Arif @ Mustakim, A-3 Mohd Wasi @ Nadeem and A-4 Raees Saleem Qureshi**, who are involved in (13) offences in the limits of Hyderabad, Cyberabad and Rachakonda Commissionarates. Gold Ornaments wg. about 130-Tulas and 1 ½ KGs Silver items and I 20 car have been recovered from their possession.

Modus Operandi:

The accused persons form as a Gang consisting of seven persons having past criminal record of committing house burglaries in different parts of the country. They come from Delhi and Meerut either in I 20 vehicle or by train, reece the local area, break open the locked houses and commit theft of gold and silver jewellery and cash.

Arrest:-

On reliable information that the accused reached Hyderabad and were planning to commit offences in and around Hyderabad were apprehended at Madhuranagar when they were moving in I 20 car.

Four out of seven accused were apprehended under the supervision of **Sri A.R Srinivas, IPS**, Dy. Commissioner of Police, West Zone, Hyderabad, by **Sri A. Vijay Kumar**, ACP, Panjagutta Division, **Sri. Y. Ajay Kumar**, DI of Police, SIs Sri. G. Srinivas and Sri. N. Sanjay Kumar and PCs Purnachander, Varaprasad Eshwar and Srikanth of SR nagar PS.

PRESS NOTE

Cyber Crime Police of CCS, Detective Department, Hyderabad, apprehended one offender by name Sheonath Prasad Kahar of North 24 Parganas district, West Bengal, who is assisting inter-state fraudsters indulging in obtaining debit/credit card details including OTP numbers from bank customers posing themselves as bank officials by providing them their address details and bank accounts on commission basis. Police seized mobile phone used in the offence from him.

FACTS OF THE CASE:

Basing on the complaint regarding receiving of phone call from unknown person posing as Bank Official who obtained two SBI debit card details and OTP numbers fraudulently and made on line transactions for total Rs.93,994/-, a case was registered vide Cr.No.210/2018 at Cyber Crime PS, CCS, Detective Department, Hyderabad and investigated into.

During the course of investigation, basing on the information provided by banks and e-commerce wallets and clues on hand, a police team proceeded to West Bengal and apprehended the accused persons. The accused was brought to Hyderabad on transit warrant and he was remanded to Judicial custody.

M.O. OF THE OFFENDER:-

The Accused person along with his associates is assisting inter-state fraudsters indulging in obtaining debit/credit card details including OTP numbers from bank customers posing themselves as bank officials by providing them their address details and bank accounts on commission basis.

The team is headed by Sri D. Prashanth, Inspector of Police, Sri G. Thimmappa, Sub-Inspector of Police, under the supervision of KCS Raghu Vir, Addl. Dy. Commissioner of Police, Cyber Crime PS, Hyderabad, apprehended the accused person.
