Hyderabad Traffic Police hereby inform the citizens of Hyderabad that Shri. N. Harikrishna, Ex-Minister and Ex-MP(RS) of AP succumbed to injuries in road accident in the early hours of 29/08/2018 in Nalgonda District. His body is kept at his residence at Mehdipatnam to facilitate VIPs and Public to pay last respect to the departed leader/Actor. On 30th August 2018 his final journey start at 4 PM from his house to Mahaprasthanam of Jubilee Hills.

Large number of followers, well-wishers and TDP activists are visiting his residence at Mehdipatnam to pay respects which has resulted in slow movement of Traffic from Ayodhya Jn.- Mahaveer Hospital – Masab Tank – NMDC – SD Hospital – Mehdipatnam route.

On 30th August 2018 at 4 PM the funeral procession will start from his house Mehdipatnam -NMDC Main Road. From there Left Turn and proceed – Mustafa Jewelers – SD Hospital – Mehdipatnam – Rethibowli – Nanal Nagar – Tolichowki Flyover – KFC – ARCHIAN Marbles – Shaikpet Nala – Bharath Petrol Pump – Oasis school – Whisper Valley Junction – Right Turn – JRC Convention and reach “Mahaprasthanam”.

All the commuters from Lakdi-ka-pool side, those who want to proceed towards Mehdipatnam, via Masab Tank NMDC, are requested to proceed via Ayodhya Junction, Bazar Ghat, Asif Nagar and reach Mehdipatnam from **6 AM to 5 PM on 30th August 2018**. Commuters from old city may take Puranapool – Hundred feet Road – Attapur to proceed towards Gachibowli. Similarly, commuters from Old City also may take Bahadurpura – ZOO Park – Shivaram Pally – Aram Ghar – Rt. Turn and Attapur Road to reach Gachibowli.

PD ACT INVOKED AGAINST SHAIK CHAND PASHA @ CHANDA S/O SHAIK AWAD CHAWOOS, AN ACTIVE ROWDY SHEETER OF BHAVANI NAGAR POLICE STATION, SOUTH ZONE, HYDERABAD

Sri Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City invoked P.D.Act Shaik Chand Pasha @ Chanda S/o Shaik Awad Chawoos, an active Rowdy Sheeter of Bhavani Nagar Police Station on 25.8.2018.

Shaik Chand Pasha @ Chanda S/o Shaik Awad Chawoos, aged about 23 years, Occ: Auto Driver, R/o H.No.18-7-426/B/97/C, Bhavani Nagar, Hyderabad, an active Rowdy Sheeter of Bhavani Nagar Police Station has been committing offences of Criminal Intimidation and attempt to commit murder in public places, in the limits of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate to demanding rowdy mamool.

He has committed **2 such offences** in the limits of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate and has been creating large scale fear and panic among the general public and businessmen in the locality, thereby adversely effecting the public order, apart from disturbing the peace, tranquillity and social harmony in the society.

Bhavani Nagar Police arrested Shaik Chand Pasha @ Chanda S/o Shaik Awad Chawoos on 21.03.2018 in Cr. No 37/2018 U/s 370 IPC of Bhavani Nagar PS and remanded him to judicial custody. The preventive detention order was executed on him on **26.8.2018** and he was lodged in Central Prison, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad.

APPREHENSION OF ONE ACCUSED WHO WAS IN POSSESSION OF NARCOTIC DRUG – SEIZED (3) KGs OF GANJA.

On 29-08-2018, the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone team, Hyderabad, apprehended one accused near Ramalayam Temple, Baphughat, Langer House Hyderabad who indulged in transporting of "Ganja" a Narcotic substance. **Seized (3) KGs of Ganja, (1) Honda Activa Bike (Black Colour) and (1) Cell phone** from his possession.

Details of the Accused:

1. Prakash Singh S/o Late Chotam Singh, aged 53 yrs, Occ: Dhobi, R/o H.No.2-31/1, Hydershakotla, Sun City, Bandlaguda, Rajendra Nagar, Hyderabad.

Details of the case:

The accused Prakash Singh is working as Dhobi. But his earnings are not sufficient to meet his family expenses. At the same time one Bhrath Singh, aged 33 yrs, R/o Laxmi Nagar, Langer House, Hyderabad who is ganja supplier advised him to work with him and sell the Ganja sachets to the needy customers by moving on bike, for which he will pay daily Rs.500/- to him. For which he agreed and worked with him. In this process he was arrested by Langer House PS in 1) Cr.No.360/2016 U/s 20(b) r/w 8(c) of NDPS Act-1985 and 2) Cr.No.01/2017 U/s 20(b) r/w 8(c) of NDPS Act-1985 of Langer House PS, Hyderabad and remanded to judicial custody.

After released from Jail he did not get any suitable job. As such he again contacted to Bharath and started to working with him for daily wages of Rs.500/-. On 28-08-2018 Bharath Singh handed over 3 KGs loose Ganja to him with instructions to pack the same in sachets and sale the same to needy customers per 1 sachet for Rs.800/- to Rs.1000/-.

Today i.e. on 29-08-2018 the accused Prakash Singh came near Ramalayam temple, Baphughat, Langer House, Hyderabad on his Honda Activa bike B.No.TS07 K TR6585 and while transporting the Ganja sachets to the needy customers, the West Zone Task Force team nabbed him along with Ganja and Bike. In this case the accused Bhrath Singh, aged 33 yrs, R/o Laxmi Nagar, Langer House, Hyderabad is at large.

The accused along with the seized material was handed over to SHO, Langer House PS, Hyderabad for further investigation.

ARREST OF NOTORIOUS AND DESPERATE BURGLER INVOLVED IN SERIES OF SHOP BURGLARIES BY NIGHT IN THE LIMITS OF NORTH ZONE AND RECOVERY OF IMPLEMENTING TOOLS, 3-MOBILE PHONES AND NET CASH RS. 11,300-00 ALL WORTH Rs. 21,300-00

Details of the accused

Ningaiyah @ Mark s/o John, 30-Years, r/o Clock Tower Garden, Secunderabad (Arrested in the early hours of 29.08.2018 at 0500 hrs. near Rethifile Bus Stand, Secunderabad)

HISTORY

In the first week of August, 2018 series of shutter lifting offences have been occurred in the limits of Market (Cr.No. 105/2018 u/s 457, 380 IPC – 05/06.08.18), Chilalguda (Cr.No. 440/18 u/s 457, 380 IPC – 07/08.08.18), Tukaramgate (Cr.No. 136/18 u/s 457, 380 IPC – 08/09.08.18), Marredpally (Cr.No. 54/18 u/s 457, 380 IPC – 08/09.08.18) and Gopalpuram (Cr.No. 217/18 u/s 457, 380 IPC – 11/12.08.18) Police Stations of North Zone and the Modus operandi was one and the same and at every crime scene burnt Match sticks and locks were found to be burnt were found by the Police and all the offences were appeared to be operated by one and the same criminal. Beside this, footages of the suspect/accused are also found captured in the CC Cameras installed in the vicinity of the crime scenes.

Apprehension

Police worked out the clues and organized a wide manhunt for locating and arresting the accused involved in the above offences and to-day i.e. on 29.08.2018 in the early hours, random checking has been organized near Rethifile Bus Stand, Secunderabad by Gopalpuram Police and during the checking they found a handicapped person trying to escape from the checking and tried to get into a moving truck. Immediately, he was chased and apprehended by the DSI, Gopalpuram P.S. On interrogation, the suspect was found deaf and dumb. He was immediately taken to NGO at Sweekar Upkar and Tests were conducted by the Specialist of Hearing Impaired and Psychologist and they concluded that the accused is exaggerating his disability and also added that accused's cunning quotient is very high. Further, requisition was given for sign language interpreter and on his instance the above offences were admitted by the accused and the stolen property has been recovered.

Recovery: Shutter lifting articles rod, torchlight, screw driver, M Seal, crackers, and match box and Rs. 11,300 from his possession.

The good work is done by SI Sri. K. Rama Krishna and crime team under the supervision of Sri K. Kiran Kumar, Detective Inspector of Police, Sri Ch. Sridhar, Dy. Supdt. of Police and able guidance of Sri. K. Srinivasa Rao, ACP Gopalapuram Division of North Zone. The staff will be rewarded suitably.
