DRUNKEN DRIVE ENFORCEMENT-2018

Hyderabad Traffic Police continuing its drive against the drunken drivers to ensure road safety. During the year -2018 in the drunken drive booked **(29484) cases including (191) Women respondents and (27383)** Charge sheets were filed against them and were produced in the Hon'ble **3rd and 4th** Metropolitan Magistrate Courts, Nampally, Hyderabad. In this regard **3rd and 4th** Metropolitan Magistrate Courts has awarded imprisonment to the **(5441)** respondents and Permanently Cancelled / Suspended Driving licenses of **(1424)** Persons for a period as mentioned below. The Hon'ble Courts imposed fine amount of Rs. **5,88,99,500/-** on the remaining **(25959)** Traffic violators. All the candidates who are sentenced for imprisonment were sent to Chanchalguda Jail. In the year **2017**, **(20811)** cases were booked and **(4015)** were convicted and **(203)** D.L were suspended.

PD ACT INVOKED AGAINST MOHD. ASAD @ ASAD S/O MOHD. ADIL, ROWDY SHEETER OF KALAPATHAR POLICE STATION, SOUTH ZONE, HYDERABAD.

Sri Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City issued P.D. Orders against Mohd. Asad @ Asad S/o Mohd. Adil, rowdy sheeter of Kalapathar Police Station on 22.12.2018.

Mohd. Asad @ Asad S/o Mohd. Adil, aged about 26 years, Occ: Videographer, r/o H.No.19-2-21/5/3/A, Biryani Shah Tekdi, Bashrath Nagar, Kalapathar, Hyderabad has committed offences of **attempt to murder, criminal intimidation, trespass and hurt in the limits of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate** causing breach of peace and tranquillity in the society.

The detenu has committed **3 bodily offences including attempt to murder** under the limits of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate and he has been creating large scale fear and panic among the general public, thereby adversely affecting the public order, apart from disturbing the peace, tranquillity and social harmony in the society.

The detenu Mohd. Asad @ Asad was absconding from the date of commission of offence in Cr.No.73/2018 U/s 147, 148, 452, 427, 324, 506 r/w 149 IPC and Sec. 25(1A) of Arms Act, 1959 of Kalapathar Police Station and in the said case he surrendered before the Hon'ble Court on 12.7.2018 and was remanded to judicial custody. Subsequently, he was released on bail on 27.7.2018. After his release from jail on bail, he committed another offence vide Cr.No.124/2018 U/s 341, 506 IPC of Kalapathar Police Station. The preventive detention order was executed on him on 27.12.2018 and he was lodged in Central Prison, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad.

**NOTE ON CORDON SEARCH HELD ON 04.01.2019 IN THE LIMITS OF
P.S.SULTAN BAZAR**

Under the supervision of Sri M. Ramesh, IPS DCP East Zone and direct supervision of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Sultan Bazar division, Hyderabad conducted cordon search on 04.01.2019 from 5 P.M to 7 P.M in the limits of P.S. Sultan Bazar. We conducted cordon and search operation with five searching parties, 6 cut off parties and three lifting parties and covered Chowdary bagh residential area. During cordon search we detained 30 two wheelers which are not having proper documents, need to verify them and 05 persons were taken into custody for moving under suspicious circumstances. Verified their antecedents, as there are no adverse remarks against them they were let of. During cordon search we interacted with the locality people, educated them about Nenu Saitham program being implemented by Police and the uses of erection of more CC TV cameras in the locality thereby to curb the offences. We have noted felt needs, most of the people complained about the illegal parking in the area by the unknown person. Further The ACP Sultan Bazar has addressed the gathering and explained the services of police i.e. Dial 100, She Team, Wow, Hawk Eye, Face Book, Twitter, Whats app and requested the colony people if any problem people can use the services of police through above. Further requested the police to take care about snatchers and tenants and furnish their information to police and created awareness about cheaters, illegal financiers and also illegal chit fund holders. (In the said cordon and search operation one ACP, 2 Inspectors, 8 SI's and 75 Staff and one special party are participated.)
