NOTIFICATION

Counting of Votes for the General Elections to the Telangana State Legislative Assembly Constituencies is scheduled on 11-12-2018 at (15) Counting Centers in the twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad.

After reviewing the situation carefully and with a view of maintain public order, peace and tranquility in the twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS., Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad in exercise of the powers conferred on me under section 22 (1) (d) to (f) and 22 (2) (a) and 22 (3) of Hyderabad City Police, Act do hereby issued the following prohibitory orders:-

1. Prohibit Assembly of (05) or more persons and any kind of processions.
2. Prohibit carrying of sticks either with or without flags, lathies, fire arms, or any other weapons which can be used as weapons for offence or defense by persons in processions, big gathering or meetings within a radius of one K.M. from the Counting Center.
3. Prohibit erection of temporary structures like Shamianas, pandals, Khannath etc., on thoroughfares, public places and all other places where public may throng.
4. Prohibit use of mikes/public address system by anybody or parties.
5. Prohibit music, singing or speeches or broadcasting through speakers or any other instruments.
6. Prohibit collection, carrying of stones and other means of casting missiles.
7. Prohibit making a speech, gesture or mimetic representation, exhibition or dissemination of pictures, symbols, placards or any other thing which is likely to create religious animosity or hatred between different communities or individuals or is likely to bring about commission of an offence of disturbance to or contempt of the law or of a lawful authority.

The following are exempted from the operation of this order:-

- a. Police Officers on duty.
- b. Military/Para Military personnel on duty.
- c. Home Guards on duty.
- d. Election Officers on duty.

The public are hereby informed that any person violating the above orders shall be liable for prosecution.

This order shall be in force with effect from 0600 hours on 11-12-2018 to 0600 hours on 12-12-2018.

PRESS NOTE

RAIDED ON ESTABLISHMENT M/S VAP ESSENTIALS @ KHAIRATHABAD SEIZED ELECTRONIC CIGARETTE MACHINES AND FLAVORS WITH NOXIUS TOBACCO – TOTAL WORTH RS. 7,00,000/- 01 HELD

On 08/09-12-2018, the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, Central Zone team, Hyderabad on credible information conducted raid on one establishment styled as VAP ESSENTIALS -situated at Flat no. 501, Nirvana Residential Flats, Khairathabad, Hyderabad and found illegal marketing and sales of noxious Tobacco contents, Electronic Cigarette Machines and flavors and apprehended **(02) accused** and Seized (60) Electronic Cigarette Machines and various flavors about 700 total seized material Market Value about **Rs 7,00,000/-**, Net Cash of Rs. 33,430/- and (03) Mobile phones.

Names of the accused Persons apprehended :-

1. Balakrishna S/o Balraj, age: 21 years, Occ: sales Manager @ Vap essentials, R/o H.No. 6-2-559, Chinthabasthi, Khairathabad, Hyderabad.
2. Kadire Kousthub Narayana Reddy S/o Vinod Reddy, age: 25 years, Occ: Owner of Vap Essentials, R/o Flat No. 502, Nirvana Residential Flats, Khairathabad, Hyderabad. **(Absconding)**

BRIEF FACTS OF THE CASE :-

The brief facts of the case are that, the accused by name Kadire Kousthub Narayana Reddy is running business (Electronic Cigarette Machines) on the name of M/s VAP ESSENTIALS situated at Flat no. 501, Nirvana Residential Flats, Khairathabad, Hyderabad by employing Balakrishna and Cherukuri Aditya for his sales and marketing noxious Electronic Cigarette Machines and various flavors illegally to gain easy profits. On observation found that he has stored, and selling the E-Cigarettes with flavors which contains Tobacco and Nicotine as ingredients in liquid form. He is running this business clandestinely & selling them to the needy customers to gain easy profits. As Telangana State has banned the sale, manufacture, distribution and storage of noxious tobacco and all its variants. The accused planned to earn easy money by way of selling of banned noxious tobacco contents in the market as it as much demand in the market and gaining easy profits illegally and violated the Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products Act (COTPA Act).

Government of India Ministry of Health & Family welfare issued an advisory stating that Electronic Nicotine Delivery Systems (ENDS) including e-Cigarettes, Heat-Not-burn devices, Vape, e-Sheesha, e-Nicotine Flavoured Hookah and the like products are dangerous to public health and Nicotine is prohibited for use as an ingredient in any food item under the Food Safety and Standards (Prohibition and Restrictions on sales) regulation, 2011 of the Food Safety and Standards Act,2006. As such States/Union

Territories are advised, in large public health and in order to prevent the initiation of ENDS by smoker/non-smokers and youth with special attention to vulnerable groups where in eminent doctors, specialists, scientists and officers of Health and Drug departments concluded based on available scientific evidences indicating that the ENDS and similar technologies that encourage tobacco (Nicotine) use, are hazardous for an active as well as passive users and have an adverse impact on public Health and may lead to Cancer and other pulmonary/respiratory diseases.

Seized Electronic Cigarette Machines and various flavors which Contains Tobacco and Nicotine as Ingredients. Seized material market value about Rs. 7,00,000/-.

The apprehended accused along with seized property was handed over to SHO, Saifabad PS for further investigation.
