

APPREHENDED ONE PERSON - RECOVERED (7) TULAS OF GOLD ORNAMENTS BY WEST ZONE TASK FORCE TEAM

On 13-01-2019 the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone Team apprehended one accused by name K.Sammaiah who committed theft of one bag which contains Gold ornaments and Cell phone in front of Yellamma Temple, Balkampet, SR Nagar, Hyderabad. **Recovered (7) Tulas of Gold ornaments and (1) Redmi Note4 Cell phone** from his possession.

Particular of accused:-

K.Sammaiah S/o K.Saiulu, aged 50 yrs, Occ: Liaison officer in TSRTC, R/o H.No.4-33-299, VenkateshwaraNagar, Jagadgirigutta, Balanagar, R.R Dist, N/o Velmajala (V), Aleru (M), Jangaon (D).

Brief about the accused:-

The accused K.Sammaiah is native of Aleru village of Jangaon District. He studied upto 7th class. Later he worked as Auto driver and Car driver in Hyderabad. In the year 1992 he got job in RTC. At present he is working as Liaison officer in TSRTC at HCU (Hyderabad Central University) Bus depot, Gachibowli, Hyderabad.

Case Facts:-

On 12-12-2018 the accused along with his family members went to attend a function at Yellamma Temple, Balkampet, SR Nagar, Hyderabad. After attending function at about 19.00 hrs he came to his bike parking place and observed that one bag was kept on his bike. He opened the bag and found that some gold ornaments and one Cell phone. By seeing the same he immediately took the bag and fled away from the spot along with the bag which contains 7 Tulas of gold ornaments i.e. Long chain, Necklace, Ear Tops, Finger Ring, Small Chain and Small finger rings and (1) Red mi note4 Cell phone.

Today i.e. on 13-01-2019 the accused came to Mythivanam, Ameerpet, Hyderabad to sell the stolen property, in the meantime on credible information the West Zone Task Force team apprehended the accused along with stolen gold ornaments and cell phone.

The accused along with the seized property was handed over to SHO, SR Nagar Police Station for further investigation in Cr.No.27/2019 U/s 379 IPC of SR Nagar PS, Hyderabad.

The accused violated the orders of Environment, Forests, Science & Technology (Env) Department, Hyderabad.

FACT OF THE CASE :-

The accused person Raj Kumar Singh residing at H.No. 13-1-943/A, Upper Dhoolpet, Mangalhat, Hyderabad. He is running Kites shop, situated at shop No. 14-11-514, Lower Dhoolpet, Mangalhat, Hyderabad from past 10 years. In the traditional Sankranthi festival he used to sell Kites and Manja of various brands, he used to manufacture Kites various models used to delivery to known and needy customers on Wholesale price. His income is not sufficient to lead lavish life, hence he hatched a plan to sell the banned "Chinese Dors" which is very demand during the Sankranthi Festival for use in the in the Kites festival to gain easy profits illegally.

The accused person have known that illegal procuring, stocking, sale and use of nylon thread which is commonly called as 'Chinese Dor' or other synthetic threads coated with glass or other harmful substances used for kite flying or other purposes and likely to cause grievous injury and inconvenience to animals including birds as well as human beings during festivals or other occasions.

The accused person used to purchase the banned CHINESE MANJA (NYLON THREAD) AND GLASS-COATED MANJA from Narsingh R/o. Mangalhat, Hyderabad and sell the same to known and needy customer in and around Hyderabad City.

The Telangana State Government under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 hereby imposes complete ban on procuring, stocking, sale and use of nylon thread, which is commonly called as 'Chinese dor', or other synthetic (non- biodegradable) threads coated with glass or other harmful substances used for kite flying or other purposes which is likely to cause grievous injury and inconvenience to animals including birds as well as human beings during festivals or other occasions. vide GO MS No. G.O.MS.No.2, Dated:13-01-2016 of Environment, Forests, Science & Technology (Env) Department, Telangana State.

Today i.e., on 13-01-2019 on tip of the Commissioner's Task Force Central Zone team conducted raid at shop No. 14-11-514, Lower Dhoolpet, Mangalhat, Hyderabad and apprehended one accused person by name Raj Kumar Singh.

Seized Synthetic nylon Chinese Manja Babins Big Size Babin's -12, Medium Size Babin's - 08, Small Size Babin's – 05 from the instance of accused person in the said shop. Seized material market worth about Rs. 25,000/-

The apprehended accused person along with seized material handed over to SHO, Mangalhat PS for further necessary legal action against them as per law U/Sec. U/s 336 IPC and sec 5 & 15 of Environmental protection Act-1986.

The accused violated the orders of Environment, Forests, Science & Technology (Env) Department, Hyderabad.

In the traditional Sankranti festival he use to sell Kites and Manja of various brands and delivery to known and needy customers on Wholesale & Retail Price. His income is not sufficient to lead his lavish life hatched a plan to sell the banned "Chinese Dors/Manja" which is very demand during the Sankranti Festival for use in the in the Kites festival to gain easy profits illegally.

The accused has known that illegal procuring, stocking, sale and use of nylon thread which is commonly called as 'Chinese Dor' or other synthetic threads coated with glass or other harmful substances used for kite flying or other purposes and likely to cause grievous injury and inconvenience to animals including birds as well as human beings during festivals or other occasions.

The accused Bade Srinivas use to purchase the banned CHINESE MANJA (NYLON THREAD) AND GLASS-COATED MANJA through dealer Bhavani & Balaji stores at Dhoolpet in low price and sell on high price to known and needy customers in the limits of Secunderabad and gain illegal easy profits.

The Telangana State Government under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 hereby imposes complete ban on procuring, stocking, sale and use of threads coated with glass or other harmful substances used for kite flying or other purposes which is likely to cause

grievous injury and inconvenience to animals including birds as well as human beings during festivals or other occasions. vide **G.O.MS.No.2, Dated:13-01-2016** of Environment, Forests, Science & Technology (Env) Department, Telangana State.

Seized Synthetic nylon Chinese Manja Bobbins & Charaka manjas from the instance of above accused in the said shop. Seized material market value about **Rs. 75,000/- (Seventy five thousand rupees).**

The apprehended accused along with seized material handed over to SHO, Bowenpally PS for further necessary legal action against them as per law U/Sec. 188, 336 IPC and Sec 15 of Environmental protection Act-1986.
