

## PRESS NOTE

### **NABBED ONE ACCUSED PERSON FOR ILLEGAL PROCURING, STOCKING, SALE AND USE OF BANNED CHINESE MANJA (NYLON THREAD) AND GLASS-COATED MANJA FOR KITE FLYING.**

On 14-01-2019 on credible information the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, Central Zone Team conducted raid at shop No. 1-9-18/6/D, Beside Indian Bank, Ram Nagar, Musheerabad, Hyderabad and apprehended one accused by name Valandas Pandurangam @ Pandu who is running Kites shop and illegal procure, stocking, sale and use of banned Chinese Manja (Nylon thread and glass coated manja for kites flying) which is harmful to animals including human beings to gain easy money illegally. The accused violated the orders of Environment, Forests, Science & Technology (Env) Department, Hyderabad.

1. Big Size Babin's -05
2. Small Size Babin's – 07 and
3. loose synthetic Nylon Coated Chinese Manja (Lacha packets)- 250

**FACT OF THE CASE :-**

The accused person Valandas Pandurangam @ Pandu residing at Gangaputra Colony, Musheerabad, Hyderabad. He is running Kites shop, situated at shop No. 1-9-18/6/D, Beside Indian Bank, Ram Nagar, Musheerabad, Hyderabad from past 02 years. In the traditional Sankranti festival he used to sell Kites and Manja of various brands, he used to manufacture Kites various models used to delivery to known and needy customers on Wholesale price. His income is not sufficient to lead lavish life, hence he hatched a plan to sell the banned "Chinese Dors" which is very demand during the Sankranti Festival for use in the in the Kites festival to gain easy profits illegally.

The accused person have known that illegal procuring, stocking, sale and use of nylon thread which is commonly called as 'Chinese Dor' or other synthetic threads coated with glass or other harmful substances used for kite flying or other purposes and likely to cause grievous injury and inconvenience to animals including birds as well as human beings during festivals or other occasions.

The accused person used to purchase the banned CHINESE MANJA (NYLON THREAD) AND GLASS-COATED MANJA from Manoj R/o. Musheerabad, Hyderabad and sell the same to known and needy customer in and around Hyderabad City.

The Telangana State Government under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 hereby imposes complete ban on procuring, stocking, sale and use of nylon thread, which is commonly called as 'Chinese dor', or other synthetic (non- biodegradable) threads coated with glass or other harmful substances used for kite flying or other purposes which is likely to cause grievous injury and inconvenience to animals including birds as well as human beings during festivals or other occasions. vide GO MS No. G.O.MS.No.2, Dated:13-01-2016 of Environment, Forests, Science & Technology (Env) Department, Telangana State.

**ARREST :-**

Today i.e., on 14-01-2019 on tip of the Commissioner's Task Force Central Zone team conducted raid at shop No. 1-9-18/6/D, Beside Indian Bank, Ram Nagar, Musheerabad, Hyderabad and apprehended one accused person by name Valandas Pandurangam @ Pandu.

**Seized Synthetic nylon Chinese Manja Babins Big Size Babin's -05, Small Size Babin's – 07 and Loose Synthetic Nylon coated Manja (Lacha Packets) -250** from the instance of accused person in the said shop. Seized material market worth about Rs. 20,000/-

The apprehended accused person along with seized material handed over to SHO, Musheerabad PS for further necessary legal action against them as per law U/Sec. U/s 336 IPC and sec 5 & 15 of Environmental protection Act-1986.
