**APPREHENSION OF ACCUSED PERSON WHO CHEATED AROUND 39
VICTIMS FOR RS. 2 CRORES**

On 03-05-2019 the sleuths of White Collar Offences Team-IV, CCS, DD, Hyderabad succeeded in the apprehension of accused person A-1 Tanikonda Venkata Kedari @ Venkat at K Perumallapuram Village, Thondangi Mandal, E.G. Dist. A.P. State who has been absconding for last 3 years.

A criminal case was registered at CCS vide Cr.No. 182/2016 U/s 406,420 IPC on the complaint of Sri. Dr. M.V.Ranga Reddy, Retired Central Govt. Doctor, as arrested accused person cheated him and other victims for Rs. 2 Crores collected in the guise of giving profits.

Modus operandi:- The prime accused A-1 K. Venkata Kedari @ Venkat worked as Manager in an Auto Garage a car mechanic shed at Gudimalkapur, Hyd and he got acquaintance with so many customers. Initially, in the year 2013 he started taking hand loans from some of the customers and used to return with some interest and gained the confidence of the customers. In the year 2015 he hatched a plan to collect the money in huge quantity from his known customers and friends and for absconding. As a part of execution of his plan, he induced the complainant and other customers, friends and some of the relatives by making dishonest promises to give good interest and to return the money in time and collected about Rs. 2 Crores. He absconded on 18th April, 2016, as per his dishonest plan, from Hyderabad. He went to Jarkhand and from there to Balasore, Odissa and stayed for about 1 ½ year. About 7 months back he came to K. Perumallapuram Village, Thondangi Mandal, East Godavari Dist avoiding to be identified by victims and others and arrested by Police.

The arrested accused person is being produced before the Hon`ble XII ACMM Court for judicial remand and the case is being investigated by Inspector of Police WCO Team IV, CCS, DD, Hyd.

- 2.** Carrying out Crime Prevention Activities.
- 3.** Conducting Regular Checking/ Surveillance over all repeat offenders residing in their respective PS jurisdiction.
- 4.** Collecting Criminal Intelligence for timely crime prevention.
- 5.** Organizing Community Policing Activities for improving Police image.
- 6.** Visible policing.

There are 122 Patro Cars and the average reaching time of patro cars to the spot in Hyderabad City is around 7 minutes. During the year patrol vehicles attended 1,96,206 emergency calls and daily average movement of the vehicles altogether is 14000 kilometers.
