

## **PRESS NOTE ON OPERATION MUSKAAN Dated: 01.08.2019**

Operation muskaan -V for tracing missing children was launched on 01.07.2019. This is a month long programme to trace missing children and rescue child labour, Children engaged in begging, etc. In Hyderabad City 17 teams were constituted each headed by SI.

During the one month operation, 445 children were

Rescued, out of which 407 are boys and 38 are girls. 51 boys were sent to rescue home at Saidabad. 13 girls were sent to rescue home at Nimboliadda. 356 boys and 25 girls were handed over to their parents, further 429 children were rescued during "OPERATION SMILE" conducted from 01.01.2019 to 31.01.2019 and therefore this year 874 children were rescued by Hyderabad City Police.

7 cases were registered against employers (i.e., auto mechanic, building contractor, Aquarium shop, matching centre, bangle shop and chicken centre) under Child Labour Act. In 431 cases labour officers imposed fine of Rs.18,70,800/- on the



employers. 7 children were rescued from begging/streets.

Special efforts were made by the rescue teams to see that these children do not again go back to work. After counselling of parents and in co-ordination with other stake holders, 6 SC children and 3 ST children, total-31 children are being admitted into residential/ other schools, so as to provide them "MUKTHI" from Child Labour.

The children were provided with school uniforms, school bags, books and stationery, etc.

All the above children were given admission letters, uniforms, school bags and books. Now they are going to schools and joined the main stream. We are grateful to the management of the hostels and schools who have agreed to provide education to these children.

## PRESS NOTE

Hyderabad Traffic Police is continuing its drive against the drunken drivers to ensure road safety. In the Month of **July-2019** caught ( **2815** ) drivers who were driving the vehicles in drunken condition. Charge sheets were filed against them and were produced in the Hon'ble 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Metropolitan Magistrate Courts, Nampally, Hyderabad. In this regard 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Metropolitan Magistrate Courts awarded imprisonment to the ( **480** ) respondents and Permanently Cancelled / Suspended Driving licenses of ( **62** ) Persons for a period as mentioned below. The Hon'ble Courts imposed fine amount of Rs. **61,35,400/-** on traffic violators. All the violators sentenced for imprisonment were sent to Chanchalguda Jail.
