

**(Abid Road police nabbed the accused Mohammed Akram @ Akram in  
Diverting Attention case, recovered stolen Net cash of Rs. 9,000/- and  
three chocolates mixed with Lorazepam-1mg tablet Cr.No. 182/2019  
U/Sec 379,420, 328 IPC**

On 26-07-2019 received complaint from Sri. Ulvaji Suresh age: 25 yrs, R/o Narsapur (V&M), Nirmal District that on 24-07-2019 at 05.40 A.M. he along with his friend Teja came to Hyderabad for medical checkup, at Gulshan Medical care, Abids. The accused approached him and asked him "whether you come for medical checkup" and continued talking with him. The accused suggested him to drink Coconut water for medical fitness and they went to a coconut shop opposite to Gandhi Bhavan, metro Station. The accused given chocolate to complaint saying that it will clear the blood. On believing his words he eaten the chocolate, became un-conscious. On 25-07-2019 at about 03.00 AM he got conscious and noticed that his Rs. 15000/-, Huawei Y-II Mobile Phone, Gold Chain, Original Passport was found missing and he suspected accused stolen the same .

During the course of Investigation collected the technical evidence C.C.T.V. Camera footages from J.N. Road, Abids identified and apprehended the accused **Mohammed Akram @ Akram S/o Mohd Ramzan , Age; 47 Years, Occ: Car Driver & Embroidery Work N/o Nagpur of Maharashtra State.** The accused confessed that he was involved in similar three cases of police stations Narayanaguda , Saifabad and Mirchowk by diverting attention who came for medical test at 1) Gulshan Medicare, Abids 2) SL Medical Kharthabad, Hyderabad 3) Mesco Diagnostic Centre, Near C.B.S., Hyderabad 4) S.K. Diagnostic Center, Nala Nagar 5) Preethi Daignostic Center at Asif Nagar and 6) Solus Health Care, Narayanguda, Hyd and target by giving chocolates mixed with Lorazepam-1mg tablet. When the victims become unconscious he commit theft of their belongings and throw away documents in dustbins.

The Modus Operandi of accused targeting the innocent people who are coming for medical test to go Gulf countries. The accused used to give chocolates mixed with Lorazepam-1mg tablet to victim make them unconscious and commit theft of cash, cell phones etc
