PRESS NOTE

A goal has been set up by Hyderabad Traffic Police with an aim of improving the safety of commuters & pedestrians by taking up various corrective measures and Road safety awareness programs in the year 2019.

The Hyderabad Traffic Police is proactively identifying the Black Spots and other accident prone areas to control the road accidents. Accordingly, (80) Black spots have been identified based on the accident data of 2018 and taken up various corrective measures at Black spots & accident prone areas in co-ordination with the Stake holders that resulted in decrease in Road fatalities during the nine months of 2019 up to 30th September.

Similarly, the Hyderabad Traffic Police proactively identified (60) Black spots on the accident data of 2019 till July and carried out Joint inspections along with Stake holders like GHMC, HRDCL, R&B, NHAI, etc. Based on the issues, various corrective measures have been taken up at several Black spots/Accident prone areas like 1) Installation of Guard railing along service road of NH-44 opp. MMR Gardens, Bowenpally Check Post. 2) Street lighting, Road markings got restored on Tippukhana - Ramdevguda Road. 3) Pedestrian Guard railing provided on central median of Raj bhavan road. 4) Central median constructed at Dathu Nagar, Midhani. 5) Flexis/Signages placed at all Metro stations to encourage the pedestrians in Road crossing by using Metro stations staircases/lifts/Escalators. 6) Chevron signages/Rumble strips got provided at the curves on NTR Marg and foot path got renovated towards Lake side. 7) Road safety Signages got erected in the limits of Tolichowki and other parts of the city.

Hyderabad Traffic Police has also conducted various awareness programs on Road safety. Particularly, reached the students by covering 1,069 Educational Institutions in 2018 and educated 2,65,319 students. In this year i.e., 2019 visited 174 Educational Institutions and educated 88,721 students. Apart from this, Enforcement is being done on accident causing violations like 1) Drunken Drive, 2) Over speeding/Dangerous Driving, 3) Minor Driving, 4) Cell Phone Driving, 5) Triple Riding, 6) Wrong side driving, 7) Extra Passengers, 8) Without Seat belt, 9) Without Helmet, 10) Signal Jumping to save the precious Lives.

Comparative statement of Road Fatalities for (9) months of 2018 & 2019 :

Due to the efforts by Hyderabad Traffic Police many lives were saved in road accidents in the first three quarters of this year 2019 when compared with the figures of 2018 till September. Similarly, the pedestrians deaths also decreased in the same period as compared to 2018.

On analysis of accident data, it is found that most of the fatal accidents occurred due to Over Speeding (116) followed by rash and Negligent Driving (46). 12 cases due to Drunk Drive, 8 cases of Negligence and 6 due to minor driving and remaining due to other reasons.

Overall analysis shows that, various Engineering measures taken up at Black spots, awareness & incentive programs on Road safety, Compliance of Helmet/Seat belt wearing rules and Enforcement on accident causing violations have resulted in overall decrease in fatal accidents in Hyderabad city.

Hyderabad Traffic Police request the Citizens to follow the traffic safety rules for the safety of all and make the Hyderabad accident free City.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 21 (1) (b) of the Hyderabad City Police Act, I, **Anjani Kumar**, I.P.S., Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, hereby notify, for information of the general public, that, in order to relieve congestion, to maintain smooth flow of traffic and to ensure public safety and order, in connection with **Grace Cancer Foundation, Hyderabad** conducting 10K, 5K & 2K runs, the following restrictions and diversions will be imposed from 0430 hours to 0700 hours on 13-10-2019.

TRAFFIC DIVERSIONS:

1. Traffic coming from VV statue towards Khairatabad flyover and Necklace Rotary will be diverted at V.V statue towards Shadan and Nirankari Bhavan.
2. Traffic coming from Telugu Thalli will be diverted at Helipad Lane towards Mint-Khairatabad (Bada Ganesh).
3. Traffic coming from Iqbal Minar intending to go towards Upper tankbund will be diverted on Telugu Thalli flyover at Old gate Secretariat
4. Traffic coming from Liberty intending to go towards Upper tank bund will be diverted at GHMC office towards BRKR Bhavan, Telugu Thalli, Iqbal Minar "U" Turn and on Telugu Thalli flyover.
5. Traffic coming from Karbala Maidan towards Upper Tank bund will be diverted at Children's Park towards DBR
6. Traffic coming from Kawadiguda X Road will not be allowed towards sailing club.
7. Traffic coming from DBR Mills traffic will not be allowed towards Children Park.
8. Traffic coming from Ministers road and Ranigunj will not be allowed towards Necklace road and the traffic coming from Ministers Road will be diverted at Nallgutta Jn., towards Ranigunj and traffic coming from Ranigunj will be diverted at Nallagutta Jn., towards Minister road respectively.

General public are requested to avoid above roads and take alternate routes to reach their destination and cooperate with the Traffic Police.
