In continuation of Road Safety Week programme and to create Traffic awareness among the youth and public, today morning at 10 AM Hyderabad Traffic Police organised "3 KM Walk" from Charminar.

In this programme Anil Kumar, IPS., Addl. Commissioner of Police, Traffic, Hyderabad addressed the gathering of 1000 school children of various educational institutions of Traffic South District. Addl. CP Tr., Hyderabad emphasis the strict observance of Road Rules from the early ages itself and explains "ABC" principles of Road Safety. Addl. CP (Tr) further made a point on "How to reduce Road fatal accidents in Hyderabad City?" and urged the students and gathering to follow Traffic Rules for their own safety and others too. APPREHENSION OF ONE ACCUSED PERSON WHO IS IN POSSESSION OF HIS VEHICLE TAYOTA REGITRATION NO. AP03 AZ **, AFTER CHAGING THE COLOUR & REGISTRATION NUMBER AND LODGED FALSE COMPLAINT AT ABID POLICE STATION STATING THAT HIS VEHICLE WAS STOLEN BY UNKNOWN PERSONS.**

On 07.02.2019 at 0800 hours at Budhera X roads, Muniapally (M), Sanga Reddy District, the sleuths of ATM team, CCS-DD, Hyderabad apprehended one person who is in possession of **his vehicle Tayota Reg.No.AP03 AZ ****, after changing the colour from white to black and changed registration number to AP03AT 0567 and lodged a false complaint at the Abids police station stating that his vehicle was stolen by unknown persons on 30.04.2018 at 1630 hours when it was parked beside Bajaj Electronic Show Room, Abids, Hyderabad with an intention to avoid payment of EMI to Clix Finance India Unlimited (formerly known as GE Capital Services India) and to claim insurance,”** police seized the vehicle Tayota Fortuner B.No. AP03 AT 0567 (Original number AP03 AZ ****), Black Color, Engine No. 1KDU 114120, Chasis No. MBJ 11 JV 6104006952-0912, Model 2012 from his possession.

Details of the Accused:

Syed Safiullah Hussaini S/o. Syed Rahamatullah, aged about 27 yrs, Occ: Advocate.

Details of the case: Crime No. 162/2018 U/Sec 379, 420, 182 IPC

The facts of the case are that the accused/complaint purchased a second hand Toyota Fortuner vehicle bearing No. AP03AZ **** from Gulam Ali of K.B. Motors, Babanagar, Chandrayangutta, Hyderabad on 18.10.2016 for Rs. 17,50,000/-. As the accused/complaint was in need of money, approach Axis Bank, Ranigunj Branch, Secunderabad and obtained vehicle loan of Rs. 10,24,000/- on 19.02.2017. Accused paid regular EMI installments for one year.

Later with an intention to cheat, the accused approach Clix Finance India Unlimited (formerly known as GE Capital Services India), Banjara Hills, Hyderabad and obtained top up vehicle loan of Rs.12,67,000/- on 28.02.2018. Out of the loan amount the Clix Finance transferred Rs.9,24,170/- to Axis Bank

and cleared the loan of Axis Bank. Rs.3,42,830/- were deposited in the account of the accused. The accused paid one EMI to Clix Finance India Unlimited. With an intention to cheat the Clix Finance India, the accused get changed the colour of the vehicle from white to black at Lower Tank Bund and also changed the Registration to AP03AT 0567. Accused took the vehicle to his native place at Budhera (V), Muniapally (M), Sanga Reddy District and kept at the backyard of his Shed.

The motive of the accused was first to get the case closed and later to claim insurance to clear the loan amount of Clix Finance India Unlimited. Later his plan was to use this vehicle.

On reliable information Inspector Sri V. Lachiram, of ATM Team CCS-DD, Hyderabad and his team SI Sri P. Srinivasulu, PC 6771 D. Srinivas, PC 8269 S.R. Arjun Anand and HG 2739 K. Jabber, apprehended the accused and recovered the vehicle, under the supervision of Sri T. Srinivas Reddy, Asst. Commissioner of Police, I/C ATM, ANC, FICN & JB Teams, CCS-DD, Hyderabad, Addl. DCP(Admin.) Sri M.A. Bari.

NARCOTIC DRUG “GANJA” PEDDLERS GANG NABBED -03 HELD

On 08-02-2019, the sleuths of Commissioner’s Task Force, North Zone team, Hyderabad apprehended (3) accused persons at Prathanth Theatre, Market Road, Secunderabad who are indulged in illegal possession of “**Ganja**” a Narcotic substance and selling to Known and needy customers on their Passenger Auto Reg no. TS13UB-5669 clandestinely and gain illegal easy money. **Seized 2.5 KGs of Ganja, Rs. 13,000/-, One passenger Auto & 02 cell phones** from their possession.

➤ **BRIEF FACTS OF THE CASE :-**

The prime accused Shaik Mustafa is at Rahamath Nagar, Yousufguda, Hyderabad. He is running Taxi auto in the limits of twin cities for his lively hood. He came into contact with his associates 1) Shyam George R/o. Clock tower, Secunderabad & 2)Gajula Srinu R/o. Bansilalpet, Secunderabad.

The accused persons are habituated consum Ganja, due to insufficient income, hatched a plan to sell the Ganja on higher price and to earn easy money illegal way they started to purchase Ganja from Ganja traffickers at Dhoolpet, Fathe Nagar on lowest price Rs.4000/- per KG and packing in 10 grams each and use to sell the Ganja sachets for Rs.80/- to 100/- each to known, needy customers and habitual consumers clandestinely in their passenger Auto Reg no. TS13UB-5669 and gain illegal easy profits.

Today the accused persons are selling Ganja sachets to customers near Prashanth Theatre, Market Road, Secunderabad laid a trap and apprehended all the accused persons along with Ganja sachets which kept in their passenger Auto.

Seized Weg 2.5 KGs of Ganja Sachets, Rs. 13,000/-, One passenger Auto Reg no. TS13UB-5669 and 02 Cell phones from their possession.

The accused persons along with the seized material were handed over to SHO, Market PS Hyderabad for further investigation.
