

**PD ACT INVOKED AGAINST MUTHYALA VIJAY KUMAR @ VIJJU, WHITE COLLAR
OFFENDER OF BEGUMPET POLICE STATION,
NORTH ZONE, HYDERABAD.**

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Sri Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City issued P.D. Orders against Muthyala Vijay Kumar @ Vijju s/o Late *****, **White Collar Offender** of Begumpet Police Station on 5.11.2018.

Muthyala Vijay Kumar @ Vijju s/o *****, aged about 53 years, Occ: Private Service, R/o H.No.10B, Eshwarpuri Colony, Sainikpuri, Secunderabad has committed offences of Cheating in the limits of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate to acquire huge easy money to lead lavish life.

The accused has committed 4 offences in the recent past under the limits of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate and has been creating large scale fear and panic among the general public, thereby adversely affecting the public order, apart from disturbing the peace, tranquillity and social harmony in the society.

Begumpet police made strenuous efforts and arrested the accused Muthyala Vijay Kumar @ Vijju s/***** on 20.6.2018 in Cr.No.185/2018 U/s 406, 419, 420 r/w 34 IPC of Begumpet Police Station and remanded him to judicial custody. The Preventive Detention Order was executed on him on 10.2.2019 and he was lodged in Central Prison, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad.

NABBED HOUSE BURGLARY GANG - 03 – HELD & RECOVERED ABOUT 23 TULAS GOLD ORNAMENTS

On 23-02-2019, the sleuths of Commissioner's Task force, East Zone Team, Hyderabad with the assistance of Hussainialam police, nabbed a notorious habitual burglary gang consisting of 03-accused namely viz., 1) Mohd Mohin, 2) Aslam Yamani and 3) Syed Majid Ahmed who are involved in Cr.No.44/2019, u/s 457, 380 IPC of Hussainialam PS and are absconding since the commission of offence. **Recovered Gold Ornaments weighing about 23-Tulas, 50-UAE Dirhams, 1900 Saudi Riyals, One US Dollar and Net cash Rs.18,000/-, Total property worth Rs.7,50,000/-** from their possession.

MODUS OPERANDI: -

- The accused Aslam Mohammed Yamani, Mohd Mohin and Syed Majeed Ahmed use to work as a personal attenders and Driver to one Syed Jamaullah Qadri @ Khusroo who is a patient at his residence situated at Hussainialam, Hyderabad from past 6 months. As the accused persons Aslam Mohammed Yamani and Mohd Mohin are irregular to their work they were removed from the job, due to which the accused persons Aslam Mohammed Yamani and Mohd Mohin developed grudge against him.
- In this process the accused Aslam Mohammed Yamani and Mohd Mohin hatched a plan to commit theft in the said residence and discussed the same with their co-worker by name Syed Majeed who is presently working at Complainant residence and promised him a share of booty, on which he agreed.
- Subsequently the accused Aslam Mohammed Yamani and Mohd Mohin informed the same to 03-other associates who are previous offenders. As per their plan in the intervening night of 18/19-02-2019 the accused person Syed Majeed Ahmed informed the other accused persons about the absence of the inmates. Thus the 05-accused reached the complainant's residence at Hussainialam and the accused Aslam Mohammed Yamani along with his associate entered into the house by break opening the lock and the remaining accused persons Mohd Mohin along with 02-other associates were present outside the house to inform the accused about the movements of people around for alerting.
- Further the accused Aslam Mohammed Yamani and his associate broke opened the wooden almirah and committed theft of gold ornaments weighing about 23 tulas along with 50-UAE Dirhams, 1900 Saudi Riyals, One US Dollar and Net cash Rs.18,000/- and all the accused sped away from the spot.

On the tip off , The Commissioner's Task Force, East Zone Team, Hyderabad City, apprehended 03-accused near Sujath Hotel, Kalapather, Hyderabad, while they were about to share the booty and **recovered Gold Ornaments weighing about 23-Tulas, 50-UAE Dirhams, 1900 Saudi Riyals, One US Dollar and Net cash Rs.18,000/-, Total property worth Rs.7,50,000/-**, from their possession.

The arrested 03 accused along with seized property were handed over to SHO, Hussainialam PS, for taking further action.

PRESS RELEASE

The Cyber Crimes PS, Detective Department, Hyderabad City have arrested accused persons 1) Ajay Lamba R/o Dabri, Delhi N/o Sirsa, Haryana State 2) Hemanth Kumar R/o Dabri, Delhi N/o Sirsa, Haryana State who were cheating innocent public in guise of gift/praccel in Cr. No. 407/2018, U/s 419, 420 IPC & Sec 66 (D) (D) of ITA Act of PS Cyber Crime and brought them to Hyderabad on transit warrant.

FACTS OF THE CASE:

The facts of the case are that on 12-12-2018 received a complaint from a lady wherein she stated that she had friendship with unknown person in social media, later he contacted in whatsapp saying that he is sending a parcel for her with gifts. Then, one day the Delhi Customs officials called her saying that she has to pay for income tax, anti-laundering, F.B.I authority etc., In this way they lured her to an amount of Rs. 7 lakhs. Hence, she requested to take necessary action against them.

2) Hemanth Kumar S/o **** age: 42 yrs, R/o ***** Dabri Delhi, N/o *****, Sirsa dist, Haryana

MO. OF THE OFFENDERS

The accused Ajay Lamba had friendship with Nigerians by names Joseph and Baba K. The Nigerians make friendship with un-known persons in facebook and would trap the innocent ladies posing themselves as financially sound abroad. After gaining confidence, they are going to send parcel/gift which contains dollars, mobile phones and jewellery etc to them. Later, the accused Ajay Lamba make a call to the victims posing as officials of Delhi Airport & customs officers etc and compel them to transfer the money to release the parcel. Accordingly, believing the versions, victims would transfer the money to the bank accounts which were provided by another accused Hemanth Kumar who also belongs to Ajay Lamba's village Sirsa, Haryana state. The accused persons were also involved in another crime in Cyber Crime PS, CCS, Hyderabad.

The public are warned to not accept such type of gifts/parcels from unknown persons who approach through Facebook and Whatsapp.

The team headed by Inspector of Police Sri G.Venkata Ramireddy consisting of team members S.Is. K.Madhusudhan Rao and M. Krishna and team members of PS Cyber Crime under the direct supervision of Addl. DCP Cyber Crimes Sri. K. C. S. Raghu Vir has cracked the said case.
