

**PD ACT INVOKED AGAINST RAGHUVVEER ROY @ RAGHU S/O SHIVANAND,
DRUG OFFENDER OF SHAH ALI BANDA POLICE STATION, SOUTH ZONE,
HYDERABAD**

Sri Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City issued a preventive detention order under the Act No.1 of 1986 against Raghuveer Roy @ Raghu s/o Shivanand on 12.2.2020.

The detenu Raghuveer Roy @ Raghu s/o Shivanand, aged about 35 years, Occ: Travels & Transport business, r/o H.No.4-11, Kontamur, Rajahmundry, East Godavari district of Andhra Pradesh was peddling Narcotic Drugs among the people **in the limits of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate** with his associates in an organized manner. He has developed widespread network, wherein he uses cell phones and other information technology devices to escape police observation.

He committed an offence in peddling of Narcotic Drugs among the people in the recent past and his illegal and highly dangerous activities in peddling of Narcotic Drugs among the people has been endangering the lives of youth and innocent people causing irreparable damage to the body organs including the Central Nervous System, thereby crippling the mental and physical health of the people addicted to drugs. His activities are prejudicial to the maintenance of public order and public health at large.

Shah Ali Banda Police arrested the detenu Raghuveer Roy @ Raghu s/o Shivanand on 27.12.2019 in Cr.No.181/2019 u/s 8 (C) r/w 20 (b) (ii) (c) of NDPS Act, 1985 of Shah Ali Banda Police Station, **seized 400 kgs of "Ganja"** from his possession and from the possession of his associates and was remanded him to judicial custody. The preventive detention order was executed on him on 18.2.2020 and he was lodged in Central Prison, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad.

He has developed widespread network, wherein he uses cell phones and other information technology devices to escape police observation.

He committed an offence in peddling of Narcotic Drugs among the people in the recent past and his illegal and highly dangerous activities in peddling of Narcotic Drugs among the people has been endangering the lives of youth and innocent people causing irreparable damage to the body organs including the Central Nervous System, thereby crippling the mental and physical health of the people addicted to drugs. IN CRIME No: 19/2020 U/S 420, 409 R/w 34 IPC

On 04-03-2020, C-Division, CCS, DD Hyderabad arrested one accused persons **Sailesh Kumar Agarwal S/o Late Mahesh Chand Agarwal age 47 yrs, Occ: Partner of M/s Dinesh Jewellers situated at Basheer Bagh Hyderabad R/o Banjara Hills Hyderabad.**

On the complainant of Sri. Arun Kumar of M/s Suraj Bhan Jewellers Hyderabad on 28.02.2020 a case in Cr.No: 19/2020 U/s 420 IPC was registered at CCS DD Hyderabad against A-1 Sailesh Kumar and other for inducing the complainant on the capacity of Merchant and took 700 KG Pure Silver for which executed two documents i.e., acknowledgement cum receipt cum undertaking and indemnity bond by the accused A-1 Sailesh Kumar Agarwal for return back the above pure silver of 700 KG on or before 1st November 2019, thereafter the accused A-1 denied to return back the same with collusion of other accused persons and thereby caused wrongful loss to the complainant and wrongful gain by the accused persons. The acts of the accused persons attracted the section of Laws 420, 409 R/w 34 IPC. The accused Sailesh Kumar Agarwal is being sent for judicial remand.

The case is being investigated by Sri. S.V. Hari Krishna, Asst.Commissioner of Police C-Division, CCS, DD Hyderabad and his team under the supervision of Addl.DCP., CCS, DD Hyderabad.
