

**ARREST OF TWO OFFENDERS AND RECOVERY OF CASH OF Rs. 32.10 LAKH BY
ABID ROAD POLICE**

Ref: Cr.No.. 56/2020 U/S 379 IPC OF ABID ROAD PS

The Crime team of Abid Road PS apprehended the two accused persons concerned in the above crime on 05-03-2020 and recovered cash of Rs. 31.10 Lakh from the possession of A-1 and Rs 1.00,000/- from A2 which was committed theft of by them on 2-2-2020 between 21.30 and 23.00 hrs. using duplicate key from the dickey of TVS Jupiter vehicle of the complainant when the vehicle was parked by him at M.J. Market Road.

DETAILS OF THE ACCUSED:

A-1 Abdul Majeed, S/o Abdul Rahman, Age: 31 years, Occ: Employee of A.M. Corporation at Pr.No. 5-1-240, Ranigunj, R/o H.No. 5-3-387/1, Hyder basthi, R.P. Road, Behind Gujarati High School, Secunderabad.

A-2 Shaheen Begum, W/o Mohammed Ashraf Ali, Age: 30 years, Occ: Working at Dandy Ice Cream parlour, R/o H.No. 2-23-53/4, Chiluka Nagar, Uppal , Ranga Reddy District

This commendable job has been accomplished by the police team by collecting technical evidence. The A-1 has taken advantage of temporary absence of the complainant on 02-03-2020, took the TVS Jupiter vehicle No. TS10EE7704 of the complainant and got prepared the duplicate key with the help of a key maker. Later A-1 called his friend A2 over telephone and asked her to meet him at City Light Hotel X Road, Secunderabad at 7.00 PM. The A-1 explained his plan of committing theft of cash from the dickey of the complainant's two wheeler and sought the assistance of A-2 and promised her to pay Rs.1,00,000/- for which the A-2 has agreed. On the evening hours 02-03-2020, A-1 went to Troop Bazaar along with the complainant and co-worker Abdul Rahman, delivered the materials and collected the cash from the shop keepers and A-1 informed the same to A-2 that they are coming to the road side eatery to have non-vegetarian snacks near GPO Bus Stop, Abids. Within few minutes, A1 called up the A2 and asked her to come to GPO bus stop and wait there for his signal. At about 09.30 PM they all reached the road side eatery and had snacks. Later the complainant crossed the road to buy Pan from a Pan Shop. Meanwhile A-1 was chatting with co-employee Abdul Rahman. At this juncture the A1 gave signal to A2 Shaheen Begum to execute the their plan. As per the plan, A-1 took Abdul Rahman to the Pan Mahal by crossing the road to collect the Pan from his owner. During that time A2 opened the dickey of Jupiter B.No. TS10ET7704 by using the duplicate key and committed theft of the cash bag containing Rs. 32.10 lakh and sped away.

ORGANIZED CRICKET BETTING RACKET BUSTED – TWO HELD

On credible information the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, North Zone Team, Hyderabad busted cricket betting racket & conducted raid at Cricket betting (Gaming) house situated at H.No: 4-8-305, Gowliguda, Hyderabad and apprehended (2) accused persons namely **1) Praveen Agarwal S/o. Ashok Agarwal & 2) Lakhan Sarda S/o. late Ramachandar Sarda (Cricket betting Sub-Organizers)** wherein the accused persons are organizing Cricket betting under main betting organizer Sanketh N/o. Rajasthan State and accepting cricket betting amount directly and indirectly, over cell phones from betting agents/punters for ongoing Cricket matches and gain illegally easy money.

➤ **DETAILS OF ACCUSED PERSONS:-**

1. Praveen Agarwal S/o. Ashok Agarwal, age. 30 yrs, occ. Betting organizer R/o. Bahuddurpura, Hyderabad (**Cricket betting organizer**)
2. Lakhan Sarda S/o. late Ramachandar Sarda , age. 29 yrs, occ. Betting organizer R/o. Gowliguda, Hyderabad N/o. Sholapur, Maharashtra State, , (**Cricket betting organizer**)

➤ **SEIZED MATERIAL:-**

1. Rs. 40,000/- (Betting amount)
2. Two cell phones

➤ **BRIEF FACTS OF THE CASE:-**

The accused Praveen Agarwal is residing at Bahuddurpura, Hyderabad and his associate Lakhan Sarda born and brought up Sholapur, Maharashtra State . Twenty years back came to Hyderabad, settled in Gowliguda, Hyderabad. They are habit of betting money on the ongoing cricket matches. Few months back they came into close with cricket betting main organizer Sanketh N/o. Rajasthan State. They hatched plan to organize cricket betting and sharing the profits. Few months back the main organizer Sanketh provided cricket betting app www.Royalexchang.com, its log ID & Pass word to the organizers. Which provides on-line score ball to ball, as well as betting ratios and used to collect betting amount from the punters clandestinely and remit to main bookie and gain easy money illegally.

The accused persons Praveen Agarwal , Lakhan Sarda are organizing betting from the residence of Lakhan Sarda situated at H.No: 4-8-305, Gowliguda, Hyderabad and used to collecting betting amount from 15 to 20 punters directly and in-directly , over cell phone for on going Test Matches & T2020 series.

➤ **ARREST:-**

The accused persons Praveen Agarwal , Lakhan Sarda (Cricket betting organizers) are organizing and accepting betting amount from punters at H.No: 4-8-305, Gowliguda, Hyderabad for the ODI Cricket match **Australia Vs South Africa** venue at Mangaung Oval Cricket Stadium, South Africa on 04-03-2020 ,

on tip of information raided the organized cricket betting gaming house and apprehended (02) accused persons.

Seized 1)Rs.40,000/- (Betting money) 2) Two Cell phones from the possession of above accused persons.

The apprehended accused persons along with seized material were handed over to S.H.O Afzalgunj PS for further investigation.

The arrest was made under the supervision of **Sri.P.Radhakishan Rao, Dy.
