MODUS OPERANDI:

The accused persons A1 & A2 who are both working as Store In-charge and driver in Partha Dental Hospital, Srinagar Colony, have hatched a plan to commit theft of two wheelers and committed theft of one bike in the month of March 2019 and as nobody has come to know about the same they committed theft of 13 bikes from month of December 2019 to till date and sold two vehicles to two different persons by telling that they will take

the balance payment after taking RC and kept with them for later disposal.

PUBLIC APPEAL:

The Public in General are appealed not to keep their bikes parked carelessly on the road and to change the worn-out keys so that it will not be opened without proper keys.

**RAIDED ON SHOP-SELLING ILLEGAL FOREIGN CIGARETTES
- TWO PERSONS HELD – SEIZED BANNED CIGARETTE
PACKETS Total Worth/Rs.90,000/-**

On 09-03-2020 night hours the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, Central Zone team along with Habeebnagar police apprehended two accused persons namely Ahmed Alam Khan and Milan Kumar Jain who were illegally procuring and selling the banned Paris, Win, ESSE and many other banned cigarettes at "Shareef Alam General Stores", situated in the Premises No: 5-7-162, Yousufian Darga, Nampally Dargah Road, Hyderabad and Seized total K-10 Cigarettes – 34 Boxes, Paris Small Cigarettes – 27 Boxes, Win Cigarettes – 57 Boxes, Shooter Cigarettes – 20 Boxes, ESSE Light Cigarettes – 13 Boxes, Ruili River Cigarettes – 04 Boxes, Paris Big Cigarettes – 66 Boxes, **total worth about Rs.90,000/-**, and (03) Cell phones and one two wheeler Br. No. TS09FB3567 from their possession.

Brief facts of the case:-

On 09-03-2020 night hours, on credible information the Commissioner's Task Force, Central Zone team along with Habeebnagar police apprehended two accused persons by name Ahmed Alam Khan and Milan Kumar Jain illegally procuring and selling the banned Paris, Win, ESSE and many other banned cigarettes at "Shareef Alam General Stores", situated in the Premises No: 5-7-162, Yousufian Darga, Nampally Dargah Road, Hyderabad.

On enquiry it is revealed that the accused Ahmed Alam Khan is running a General Store in the name styled as "Shareef Alam General Stores", situated in the Premises No: 5-7-162, Yousufian Darga, Nampally Dargah Road, Hyderabad. He got introduction with one person by name Milan Kumar Jain who use to supply illegal banned cigarettes to needy shops in the market. Then Ahmed Alam Khan planned to sell the illegal banned cigarettes to needy customers and gain illegal profit. These cigarettes cause endanger to the human life and hazardous to environment as the contain a very high content of tobacco. In this process Milan Kumar Jain who came to the shop of Ahmed Alam Khan to supply the illegal banned cigarettes.

Modus operandi: -

Win and other banned foreign cigarettes suspected to be coming from China and Bangladesh via Kolkata. Smuggling foreign cigarettes is a lucrative business to black marketers as they avoid customs duty. Smuggled cigarettes do not have pictorial warnings on them, as it is mandatory as per the provisions of Sec.20(2) of Cigarette and Other Tobacco Product Act 2003. The cigarettes do not have manufacturing addresses on the packets and no bills of procuring or importing. The margin involved in smuggling of cigarettes is almost 100%.

Win and many other foreign cigarette brands are cheap and which are available for a low price, act as a replacement to beedis in India. Many foreign cigarettes contain a very high content of tobacco dust which is especially injurious to health. In spite of their hazardous nature, foreign brand cigarettes are a big hit among youth due to their slim and distinct flavor. They counter parts in other states from where these cigarettes are believed to be smuggled. The increase of smuggling of cigarettes into the country is only robbing the government taxes and leading to the effect on tobacco farmers in the country.

Hence the arrested accused persons along with seized material were handed over to SHO, Habeebnagar PS, for further investigation.
