PD ACT INVOKED AGAINST SHAIK OBAID S/O SHAIK AZAM, PROPERTY OFFENDER OF KANCHANBAGH POLICE STATION, ROWDY SHEETER OF KALAPATHAR POLICE STATION, SOUTH ZONE, HYDERABAD

Sri Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City issued a preventive detention order under the Act No.1 of 1986 against Shaik Obaid s/o Shaik Azam, property offender of Kanchanbagh Police Station on 13.2.2020.

The detenu Shaik Obaid s/o Shaik Azam, aged about 32 years, Occ: Auto Driver, r/o H.No.19-2-113/1, behind Ashur Khana, near Kalapathar Police Station has been **habitually committing robbery, theft by diverting attention and extortion in the limits of Hyderabad and Cyberabad Police Commissionertes** to make easy money and to lead lavish life.

He committed 3 more offences in the recent past and has been creating large scale fear and panic among the general public and acting in a manner prejudicial to the maintenance of public order apart from disturbing the peace, tranquillity and social harmony in the society.

Kanchanbagh Police arrested the detenu Shaik Obaid s/o Shaik Azam on 24.10.2019 in Cr.No.217/2019 u/s 420, 379 r/w 34 IPC and Sec.25 (1) (b) of Arms Act of Kanchanbagh Police Station and remanded him to judicial custody. The preventive detention order was executed on him on 17.2.2020 and he was lodged in Central Prison, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad.

The Cyber Crime Police, CCS, DD, Hyderabad City arrested one person Rahmath Shareef age: 29 years, Hyderabad who is involved in circulating a fake news through social media and causing breach to public peace and tranquility.

Facts of the case:

Cyber Crime Police registered a suomoto case vide in Cr.No. 520/2020 U/Sec. 505 (1) (C), 505 (2) IPC, regarding a audio clip is circulating on social media platform. The accused prepared a inflammatory audio message and was circulating on social media platform. This audio clip would have escalated communal tension among different communities create violence caused and breach to public tranquility.

As per the preliminary investigation, alleged accused is working as a van driver in private school & works as an auto driver as a part time job. On 08-03-2020 the accused has seen one text message in WhatsApp regarding Delhi incident on a whatsapp group. After seeing that message, intentionally he had recorded an audio clip with his own voice regarding Delhi communal rights which would have created violence promoted enmity between different groups on ground of religion to cause breach to public tranquility. After recording the audio, he circulated it through WhatsApp.

INTER-STATE NARCOTIC DRUG “GANJA” PEDDLERS GANG NABBED

-04 HELD, SEIZED 96 KGS OF GANGA WORTH ABOUT Rs.6,70,000/-

On credible information the sleuths of Commissioner’s Task Force, North Zone team, Hyderabad along with Police Malakpet PS laid a trap near Venkatadri Theatre, Dilsukh Nagar, Malakpet, Hyderabad and apprehended **(4) accused persons** 1) Kayyam Nagaraju 2) Peeri Chinna Rao 3) Margal Durga Babu & 4) Gollori Narsimha who are indulged in illegal possession Narcotic drug “**Ganja**” and waiting to delivery to drug peddler Duggimpudi Shiva Shankar Reddy in Hyderabad clandestinely and gain illegal easy money. **Seized 96 KGs of dry Ganja, 03 cell phones & Rs. 2,000/-** from their possession. Seized Ganja worth about 6,70,000/-

➤ **DETAILS OF THE ACCUSED:**

1. Kayyam Nagaraju S/o. late K.Babu Rao, age. 26 yrs, Occ. Agriculture R/o. Gudem Colony village, Gudem Kotha veedhi Mandal, Vishakapatnam Dist, Andhra Pradesh State,
(Growing Cannabis plants at Populuru village, Odisha state and supply to **Drug peddlers**)
2. Peeri Chinna Rao S/o. P.Bangarayya, age. 28 yrs, occ. Agriculture R/o. Kanmabhi Camp, Sileru village, Gudem Kotha Veedhi (Mandal), Vishakapatnam (Dist), Andhra Pradesh State, (Growing Cannabis plants at Populuru village, Odisha state and supply to **Drug peddlers**)
3. Margal Durga Babu S/o. M.Chinna Rao, age. 21 yrs, Occ. Auto driver, R/o. Velarathi (Village), Vayaravaram (Mandal), East Godavari Dist, Andhra Pradesh State, (**Associate**)
4. Gollori Narsimha S/o. late G.Gurumurthy, age. 30 yrs, Occ. Auto driver R/o. Sarapaka (Village), Burgampadu Mandal, Bhadradri Kothagudem Dist, Telangana State (**Associate**)

➤ **SEIZED MATERIAL :**

1. **96 KGs of Dry “Ganja” (Narcotic drug)**
2. 03 Cell phones
3. Rs.2,000/-

➤ **Modus operandi**

The accused persons Kayyam Nagaraju & Peeri Chinna Rao are clandestinely growing Cannabis plants in forest area in Populuru village of Odisha state, later with their associates Margal Durga Babu , Gollori Narsimha use to supply the Ganja to drug peddler Duggimpudi Shiva Shankar Reddy at Hyderabad and other ares. The drug peddlers are smuggling ganja packets from Sileru, Vishakapatnam & Bhadrachalm to Hyderabad in private buses from one place to another places and delivery to drug peddlers.

The accused persons are supply the Ganja for **Rs.1500/-** per kilogram to Drug peddler Duggimpudi Shiva Shankar Reddy and others. The drug peddler are sell the same for Rs. 7,000/- to their needy customers, thereby gain illegal easy profits.

➤ **Brief history of accused persons**

The accused Kayyam Nararaju born and brought up Gudem colony village, later settled in Sileru village, Vishakapatnam Dist, **AP State**. He is a former by profession due to financial problems growing cannabis plants at Populuru Village, Malakngiri Dist , Odisha State and delivery to drug peddler to gain easy money illegally.

The accused Peeri Chinna Rao is born and brought up Iskalamamadi village, Malakngiri Dist, **Odisha State** and settled in Sileru village, Vishakapatnam Dist. He is brother in law of Kayyam Nararaju and both are cultivating Cannabis plants at Populuru village, Odisha State delivery to drug peddler.

The accused Margal Durga Babu is native of Velarathi village, **West Godavari Dist**, AP State. He is running Passenger auto for his lively hood and accompany with above accused persons in transporting of Narcotic drug “Ganja” on commission basis.

The accused Gollori Narsimha is native of Sarapaka village, **Bhadradi-Kothagudem Dist**, Telangana State. He is doing as auto driver for his lively hood and associate of drug peddler Duggimpudi Shiva Shankar Reddy in dealing in between Ganja suppliers on commission basis.

➤ **Facts of the Case :-**

The accused persons 1)Kayyam Nagaraju , 2) Peeri Chinna Rao are family relatives. Due to financial problems hatched a plan to cultivate Cannabis plants and delivery to drug peddlers to gain easy money illegally.

As per their plan from one year they have been growing Cannabis plants in the remote forest area of **Populuru village, Odisha state** which is boarder area of Sileru village of Vishakapatnam Dist. After full develop the crop the Cannabis buds are dried leaves "Ganja" and sealed in airtight package, use to delivery to drug peddlers clandestinely.

In this process one week back the main drug peddler Duggimpudi Shiva Shankar Reddy R/o. Hyderabad, native of Sarapaka village, Kothagudem-Bhadari Dist, TS State along with his associate Gollori Narsimha R/o. Bhadradi Kothagudem Dist came into contact with the suppliers 1)Kayyam Nagaraju, 2) Peeri Chinna Rao and set a deal with them for transporting of Ganja to Hyderabad.

As per the plan of main drug peddler Duggimpudi Shiva Shankar Reddy the accused persons 1)Kayyam Nagaraju , 2) Peeri Chinna Rao along with their associates Margal Durgba Babu, Gollori Narsimha have procured about 96 KGs of Ganja and the material kept in plastic bags from there came to Bhadrachalam and boarded private bus by concealed the ganja packets, got down in the limits of Malakpet, Hyderabad and waiting to delivery to drug peddler Duggimpudi Shiva Shankar Reddy.

Arrest :-

Meanwhile on tip of information the Commissioner's Task Force, North Zone team and Police Malakpet PS laid a trap near Venkatadri Theatre, Dilsukh Nagar, Malakpet, Hyderabad and apprehended (4) accused persons 1) Kayyam Nagaraju 2) Peeri Chinna Rao 3) Margal Durga Babu & 4) Gollori Narsimha along with Narcotic drug Ganja bags.

Seized total Weighing 96 KGs of Ganja, 03 cell phones & Rs. 2,000/- from the possession of above accused persons.

The accused persons along with seized material handed over to SHO, Malakpet PS for further investigation and registered a case in **Cr.No.73/2020, U/s. 8(c) R/w.20(b)(ii)&(C) of NDPS Act-1985.**
