NOTIFICATION

Whereas, the area known as High Court of Telangana State, Hyderabad in the limits of Charminar Police Station, together with its surrounding roads and areas including the following roads, are busy places due to functioning of the High Court of Telangana State causing movements of litigants and Advocates to and from the premises of High Court of Telangana State.

- 1) On the Northern side of the High Court Building : City College Junction to Nayapul Road.
- 2) On the Southern side of the High Court Building : Madina Circle to City College Road and its (3) by lanes leading to Ghansi Bazar and other (3) by lanes leading to Patel Market/Ricobgunj.
- 3) Nayapul – Madina Circle – High Court Road
- 4) Pathargatti – Madina Circle – High Court Road
- 5) Muslim Jung Bridge Circle to High Court Road
- 6) Puranapul – PTO – City College X- Road – High Court Road
- 7) Moosa Bowli – Mehandi – City College X- Road – High Court Road.

2. And whereas, reports have been received indicating that such conditions now exist that unrestricted holding of public meetings, processions/ demonstrations, etc. in the area is likely to cause obstruction, annoyance or injury to any person lawfully employed, or danger to human life, health or safety or disturbance of the public tranquility or a riot or an affray and inconvenience in the smooth functioning of the Hon'ble High Court of Telangana State and disturbance to the litigants and Advocates.

3. And whereas, it is considered necessary to take speedy measures in this behalf to prevent danger to human life, health or safety or for preventing a riot or any affray and disturbance of public tranquility.

4. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 144 of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 and under Sec. 22 of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli, I, Anjani Kumar,IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the general public prohibiting the following matters :-

- i) the holding of any public meeting;
- ii) assembly of five or more persons;
- iii) carrying of fire-arms, banners, placards, lathis, spears, swords, sticks, bricksbats, etc.;
- iv) shouting of slogans;
- v) making of speeches, etc.;
- vi) processions and demonstrations; and
- vii) Picketing or dharnas in any public place within the area specified in the schedule and sketch map appended to this order without a written permission.

5. As the order cannot be served practicably to each individual on all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte and the same is published for the information of public through Press and by affixing copies of this order on the notice boards of the offices of all the D.Cs.P., Addl.DCsP., A.Cs.P., all Police Stations concerned and other places for conveying the information to the general public.

6. Religious functions/ rallies/ public meeting, etc. in the above specified areas can be held with prior written permission from the Dy.Commissioner of Police, South Zone, Hyderabad well in advance and this order shall not apply to processions which have the requisite permission of the concerned Zonal Dy.Commissioner of Police/Divisional Asst.Commissioner of Police.

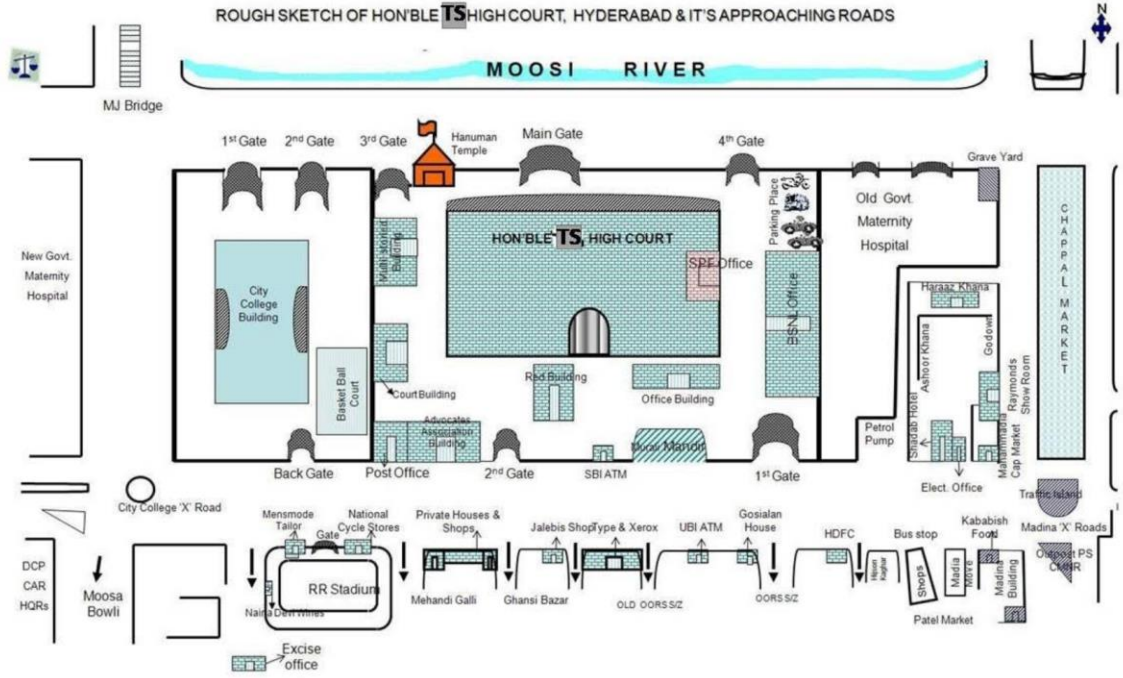
7. This order shall come into force with effect from 0600 hours on 15.03.2020 and shall remain in force for a period of two months i.e. upto 0600 hours on 13.05.2020 (both days inclusive) unless withdrawn earlier.

8. Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code and as per the provisions of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

NABBED ONE BIKE OFFENDER - RECOVERED (2) BIKES

On 12-03-2020 the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone team apprehended one accused person by name Mohd Sameer @ Ashwaq @ Goli who committed (2) bike theft offences in the limits of Vanasthalipuram PS and Adibatla PS, of Rachakonda Commissionerate and absconded since commission of offence. **Recovered (2) Honda Activa Bikes B.No.TS08EH6858 and TS08EW3829** from his possession.

Particular of accused:-

Mohd Sameer @ Ashwaq @ Goli S/o Late Mohd Razak, aged 46 yrs, Occ: Unemployee, R/o Plot No 27, Anand Colony, RTC Colony, Back side of Bawarchi Hotel, Hayathnagar, Hyderabad

Brief about the accused:-

The accused Mohd Sameer @ Ashwaq @ Goli is native of Hyderabad. He is having three brothers and three sisters. He is illiterate, Earlier he was married with Rehana begum and later he got second marriage with Shabana begum and blessed with one son by name Mohd Shanawaz. At present he is living alone near RTC Colony, Hayathnagar and working as daily hamali.

Modus operandi:-

The accused person Mohd Sameer @ Ashwaq @ Goli is habitual offender and committed Robberies, Chain Snatchings, Automobile theft. Previously he was arrested by Jeedimetla, Dhundigal, Balangar, Bowenpally PS's of Cyberabad and Hyderabad Commissionerates. In the month of October-2019 Police Dhundigal arrested the accused person Mohd Sameer @ Ashwaq @ Goli in Cr.No.537/2019 U/s 379 IPC for committing bike theft of New Activa 5G T/R No TS10ATTR0730 and remanded him to judicial custody. Even after releasing from jail he habituated for committing of thefts and he used to wander in the area in late night hours and used to made recce an isolated places for committing offences. After completion of recce he will commit bike thefts and use the same bike by changing number plates.

From the past three months the accused person committed theft of following cases.

1) Cr.No.255/2020 U/s 379 IPC of Vanasthalipuram PS (Honda Activa Bike B.No.TS 08 EH 6858)

2) Cr.No.25/2020 U/s 379 IPC of Adibatla PS (Honda Activa Bike B.No.TS08EW3829)

Previously the accused was arrested involved in five cases in the limits of Jeedimetla and Dhundigal PS of Cyberabad.

Today i.e. on 12-03-2020, the accused person Mohd Sameer @ Ashwaq @ Goli was roaming on stolen bike to sell the stolen property, in the meantime the West Zone Task Force team apprehended him along with stolen property.

The accused person along with the recovered property was handed over to SHO, Vanasthalipuram Police Station in Cr.No.255/2020 U/s 379 IPC and Cr.No.25/2020 U/s 379 IPC of Adibatla PS for further investigation.

The arrests were made under the supervision of **Sri P.Radha Kishan Rao, Dy.Commissioner of Police**, Commissioner's Task Force, by **Sri B.Gattu Mallu**, Inspector of Police, Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone team, SIs Sri Md.Mujaffar Ali, Sri P.Mallikarjun, Sri N.Ranjith Kumar and the staff of West Zone Team, Commissioner's Task Force, Hyderabad.
