

**PD ACT INVOKED AGAINST MUKESH LAL RAJPUTH @ MUKESH S/O

Sri Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City issued preventive detention order under the Act No.1 of 1986 against Mukesh Lal Rajputh @ Mukesh s/o late Babu Lal Rajputh, aged about 23 years, Occ: Painter, r/o S.C.B No.2-24-035, Gun Bazar, Begumpet, n/o H.No.1-11-107-1, Ashok Colony, Kagaz Nagar, Kumuram Bheem district, property offender of Begumpet Police Station, on 24.02.2020.

The detenu Mukesh Lal Rajputh @ Mukesh s/o late Babu Lal Rajputh has been **habitually committing property offences in the limits of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate.**

Begumpet Police arrested the detenu Mukesh Lal Rajputh @ Mukesh s/o late Babu Lal Rajputh on 27.12.2019 in Cr.No.555/2019 of Begumpet Police Station and remanded him to judicial custody. The preventive detention order was executed on him on 26.2.2020 and was lodged in Central Prison, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad.

**TRAFFIC ADVISORY**

Traffic restrictions/diversions in connection with widening of road at Panjagutta Grave yard (near chutneys) and construction of steel bridge was notified to citizens vide notification No. Tr.T5/327/2020, Dated:03-03-2020 of Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City and given vide publicity that the traffic regulations will be continued up to 03-06-2020.

In connection with the above restrictions/diversions, Hyderabad Traffic Police inform all the citizens that the main works are going to start from tomorrow onwards i.e., from 14-03-2020.

Therefore, the heavy vehicles like RTC Buses/Private Buses/School and College buses/Lorries/DCMs/Water Tankers/ Petrol Tankers/Cement Ready Mix Vehicles etc., will not be allowed beyond SNT junction towards NFCL and Panjagutta. Therefore the above said heavy vehicles owners and drivers are requested to take alternate routes while coming from filmnagar junction, Road no.45 junction and Road No.36 etc. They are advised to take the following suggested alternate routes:

1. From Jubilee Hills Check Post - Venkatagiri - Krishna Nagar - Yousufguda check post - Yousufguda Basti (Setwin office) - Maitrivanam, Ameerpet.

(OR)

2. From Jubilee Hills Check post - Road No.45 Jubilee Hills - BVB Junction - Orissa island - road no.12 Banjarahills - Road no. 1, Banjarahills.

All citizens and other commuters are also requested to take alternate routes to reach their destinations and avoid the above route and co-operate with the Traffic Police during the period of road widening and steel bridge work.

## **PRESS RELEASE**

The Cyber Crime Police, CCS, DD, Hyderabad City arrested one person Vennala Venkatesh, age: 25 years, N/o. Vizianagaram Dist. Andhra Pradesh who is involved created fake profiles on girls/women name by downloading girls/women pictures from social media accounts and by providing his WhatsApp number in the name of online sexual video chat and deposited huge money in his bank account.

### **Facts of the case:**

Facts of the case are that, on 29-02-2020 at 12:00 hrs received a complaint from one lady victim in which she stated that some unknown person created a fake Tinder (dating app) accounts by mentioned WhatsApp number with her personal photos and chatting with others by using her photos. She came to know through one of her mutual friend that, an unknown person was communicating with different persons by way of online sexual video chat and sharing his bank account details and Google pay number and collecting huge money from them by impersonating as the complaint.

Basing on the contents of the complaint registered a case in Crime No.467/2020 U/s. 66D ITA Act-2008 & Sec. 420 IPC for further investigation.

As per the preliminary investigation, accused used to create fake profiles on social media platform especially in dating apps by using girls/women pictures which were downloaded from different social media accounts. If he was contacted through WhatsApp messenger he would sexual chat and send the downloaded girls photos to them by impersonating as those girls/women. This way he cheated the people by collecting money from them by providing his bank and Google pay account details. After getting money immediately, he blocked their contacts and deleted the chat. If the created fake accounts were de-activated/deleted he would another fake profiles with same photos/names and used for same. In the same manner he had contacted anonymous persons on sexual website <https://telugu-sex-chat.chatovod.com/> and cheated them. From last one year, accused cheated the peoples to the tune of approximately Rs. 20 lakhs.

## NABBED TWO CELL PHONE SNATCHING OFFENDERS & RECOVERED ONE CELL PHONE AND TWO-WHEELER

On 12-03-2020, the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, Central Zone team apprehended (02) accused persons of Cell phone snatching gang by name Vemula Balraj @ Laddu and one Child in Conflict with Law, who committed (01) Cell phone Snatching offence on their Honda Dio bike in the limits of Nampally, recovered (01) Smart Mobile Phone which belongs to victim & (01) Honda Dio vehicle Reg no. TS08BNTR2357 (which was used in the commission of offence) from their possession.

**Brief Facts:**

The accused Vemula Balraj @ Laddu is native of Balaji Nagar, RR District. He discontinued his studies after 9<sup>th</sup> class. He used to work as lathe machine worker for his livelihood. He is addicted to bad Habits (Alcohol and cigarette smoking etc.). As such he could not full fill his needs as his earning were not sufficient to fulfil his needs and luxurious/lavish life. In the year 2019, he along with his friends formed a Gang and started House thefts & Robberies. In the month of June-2019, he was arrested by Kushaiguda Police and was released on bail. After releasing from jail, he made friendship with one Child in Conflict with Law who is residing in the same locality at Balaji Nagar. They both hatched a plan to earn easy money by way of committing cell phones Snatching from innocent people. According to their plan they committed **01 Cell phone Snatching** offence in the limits of Nampally PS on 29-02-2020.

On a credible information the Commissioner's Task Force, Central Zone Team, Hyderabad, apprehended the accused and recovered the Snatched Smart Mobile phone and One Honda Dio Reg. No. TS08BNTR2357 from their possession.

After reaching Hyderabad in the early hours of 06-03-2020 at about 0300 hours Zaheer went to owners house and broke open the main door locks and bedroom almirah and stolen Rs.19,00,000/-. After committing offence he went to Goa to enjoy lavishly and to play Casino.

The accused person is habitual of playing cards, betting's and Casino.
