

**NABBED THE ACCUSED PERSON IN CR.NO.187/2020 U/S. 408, 420  
IPC OF CHILKALGUDA PS, HYDERABAD CITY WITH COMBINED  
EFFORTS OF POLICE WITH PUBLIC.**

On credible information the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, North Zone team, Hyderabad nabbed the accused Dondapati Prakash. Seized net cash of **Rs.90 Lakhs** at the instance of the accused.

➤ **Details of Accused:**

Dondapati Prakash S/o. late D.Veer Raju, age. 35 yrs, occ. Driver in SIPL (Securitrans India Pvt Ltd) R/o. Sai Nagar colony, Nagole, Hyderabad N/o. Sanjeevaiah Nagar, Nidadavolu, West Godavari Dist, AP State.

➤ **Facts of the FIR : Cr.No.187/2020, U/s. 408, 420 IPC of Chilkalguda PS**

On 16-03-2020 at about 1800hrs the complainant Poojala Harish(Manager of CMS Info system Ltd) lodged a complaint at Chilkalguda PS stated that on 16-3-2020 at about 1030 hrs their staff four members i.e. driver, gunman & two custodians went to SBI, main branch, Koti on their ATM cash van Reg no. AP16TD-4451 (Bolero) and took indent from the bank employee and withdrawn Rs.1 Crore 60 lakhs and started to refill the money in ATM centers and firstly the team reached SBI, ATM near Shiva Point, Chilkalguda, Sec'bad at 1300 hrs then the custodians & gun man got down at ATM center, entered into the SBI ATM with Rs 68, lakhs, while the custodians were filling the cash into the ATM machine, meanwhile the suspect driver fled away with the vehicle containing with Rs. 92 Lakhs cash. Later the vehicle abounded at Lalaguda fly over and the driver with the cash found missing.

➤ **CMS Info System Ltd:-**

The **CMS** (Cash Management Service info system Ltd) office situated at Lower Tank Bund, Hyderabad and its main office located at Mumbai. They used to collect money from the Public, Private sector banks and replenish the cash in the various ATMs of Public, Private sector Banks. The CMS info System Ltd is operating 60 cash transporting vehicles with 400 employees in twin cities.

➤ **Brief history of accused:-**

The accused Dondapati Prakash, aged.35 yrs is native of Nidadavolu, West Godavari Dist, A.P State. He studied upto Polytechnic Diploma in Civil Engineering from Andhra Polytechnic College, Kakinada from the year 2001 to 2004. After that he worked as Site Engineer in private construction firms at AP, MP, Tamilnadu States from 2005 to 2014. In the year 2015 he got married, he shifted his residence to Sai Nagar Colony, Nagole, Hyderabad in the year of 2017. He worked as Cab driver under UBER Public Transport services. Later he came to know that the CMS info is transporting huge amount from Banks to refill in various ATMs in the Twin cities.

➤ **Motive:-**

The accused himself informed to his family & friends circle that he is doing as Civil Engineer at Hyderabad. He planned to knock away the bank money for his settlement in life. For which he hatched a plan to commit theft of cash from Cash transport vehicle and waiting for an opportunity.

As per his plan, in the month of **August-2019** he was appointed as driver by Five star Facility Solutions (India) Pvt. Ltd, situated at Kavadiguda, Hyderabad to work in SIPL (Securitrans India Pvt. Ltd) situated at Diamond Point, Bowenpally. He joined in the Job and used to transport huge cash from Banks and refill in the ATMs, he also worked as Van driver in CMS info system Ltd through SIPL and waiting for an opportunity to execute his plan.

➤ **Execution of Plan :-**

On 16-03-2020 the accused Dondapati Prakash went to CMS vehicle's parking place, situated at Kavadiguda, he covered his face with hand kerchief & head with a cap, approached the Parking security Guard Kunta Yadagiri and the accused introduced himself as Rakesh (fake name), driver of Five Star security service and took the vehicle Keys of AP16TD-4451 (Bolero) from Security guard.

After that the accused along with the vehicle reached CMS office, situated at Lower Tank Bund, Hyderabad and met with the vehicle movement Coordinator Anil Kumar Yadav told that he came from Five Star security Service along with route vehicle. The coordinator deployed one gunman Ravi kumar along with two custodians namely Thavidaboina Ravi Kumar & Vemuganti Jagannatha Rao in order to transport the cash from SBI Bank to ATMs.

After that the accused Dondapati Prakash (vehicle driver) along with Gunman two custodians left from CMS office to SBI, Koti Branch at 1230 hrs. The custodians through Executive Bank Coordinator Kiran Kumar received an amount of Rs.1 crore 60 Lakhs from SBI, Koti and started along with cash. Firstly they reached **SBI ATM, near Shiva tea point, Chilkalguda at 1335 hrs** and filled the ATM with Rs.68 Lakhs (Sixty eight lakhs), gunman Ravi kumar, Custodians Thavidaboina Ravi Kumar & Vemuganti Jagannatha Rao got down from the vehicle to refill in the SBI ATM Machine.

While refilling the ATM by custodians, the accused informed to gun man that he will take u turn of the vehicle and fled away with the cash in the same vehicle. He abandoned the vehicle near Lalaguda fly over and fled away with cash.

➤ **Investigation & Arrest :-**

- From Chilkaiguda to Nagole entire North Zone Task Force team consisting of 28 members scanned nearly 500 CCTV footages in 36 hours.
- During the CCTV footage analysis we found that the accused stepped in an Auto.
- The Auto was traced, basing on the clues given by the Auto the area (i.e. Nagole) where the accused got down with two bags.
- Task Force team verified the almost every house in the colony finally identified the accused house with the help residents.
- Today i.e. on 19-03-2020 at early hours the accused came to his house along with cash, immediately our Task Force staff who were waiting for him apprehended the accused and recovered an amount of cash Rs.90 Lakhs from the accused.
- The accused is being handed over to SHO, Chilkaiguda Police Station for further investigation.
