

**PD ACT INVOKED AGAINST MOHAMMED KHADEER S/O LATE
MOHAMMED YOUNUS, PROPERTY OFFENDER OF FALAKNUMA POLICE
STATION, SOUTH ZONE, HYDERABAD**

Sri Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City issued preventive detention order under the Act No.1 of 1986 against Mohammed Khadeer s/o late Mohammed Younus, **property offender** of Falaknuma Police Station on 6.3.2020.

The detenu Mohammed Khadeer s/o late Mohammed Younus, aged about 25 years, Occ: Auto Driver, r/o Hassan Nagar, Hyderabad, property offender of Falaknuma Police Station **committed offences including theft of mobile phones, robbery and extortions in the limits of Cyberabad and Hyderabad Police Commissionerates.**

He has committed 5 property offences in the recent past and has been creating large scale fear and panic among the general public and acting in a manner prejudicial to the maintenance of public order apart from disturbing the peace, tranquillity and social harmony in the society.

Falaknuma Police arrested the detenu Mohammed Khadeer on 24.10.2019 in Cr.No.319/2019 u/s 384 IPC of Falaknuma Police Station and remanded him to judicial custody. The preventive detention order was executed on him on 7.3.2020 and he was lodged in Central Prison, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad.

Today (20th March, 2020) The Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad city, Sri. Anjani Kumar,IPS, GHMC Commissioner DS. Lokesh kumar,IAS AND Collector Hyderabad Smt.Sweta Mohanty ,IAS were conducted meeting with all religious heads of Hyderabad city, regarding how to take precautionary measures about CORONA VIRUS. Smt.Shikha Goel,IPS, Addl.CP. Crimes and Sri.Tarun Joshi,IPS, Jt.CP.SB also present in the meeting. It was attended by 100 religious leaders from all communities. They all have taken a decision that there will not be any gathering in any religious places.

Cyber Crime Police of CCS, Detective Department, Hyderabad, apprehended (2) two offenders namely 1) Mansur Ansari S/o Kayum Ansari, age 40 yrs, 2) Aslam Raja S/o Chirauddin Ansari, age 21 years, both R/o Pipra (village), Deoghar, Jharkhand, who are posing as customer care of Lime Road App and fraudulently obtains the UPI activation link and fraudulently transfers the amount from the bank accounts and cheating the customers. Police seized (3) mobile phones used in the offence from the possession of accused.

FACTS OF THE CASE:

On 07-01-2020, Sri Arjun Singh Bhojak of South Lalaguda, Secunderabad, lodged a complaint stating that he ordered a shirt online (1+1 offer) in Lime Road App, but on receiving only one shirt instead of two shirts, he called the customer care number by searching in Google for return of his amount. His call was disconnected by the customer care and he received call from another phone No. and the person who posed as customer care of Lime Road App, in order to return his amount, sent him a message and made him to forward to their Head Office No. and fraudulently transferred Rs.37,288/- from his bank account. Basing on his complaint, a case was registered vide Cr.No. 56/2020, U/Sec. 66 (C) (D) I.T.A Act 2008, Sec.419, 420 IPC at Cyber Crime PS, CCS, Hyderabad and investigated into.

During the course of investigation, basing clues police team lead by Sri D. Prashanth, Inspector of Police, Cyber Crime PS, CCS, Hyderabad, proceeded to Jharkhand and apprehended the accused persons. They were brought to Hyderabad on transit remand and are being remanded to Judicial custody.

Details of the arrested persons :-

- A1) Mansur Ansari S/o Kayum Ansari, age 40 years, Occ: Mestry R/o Pipra village, Deoghar, Jharkhand.
- A2) Aslam Raja S/o Chirauddin Ansari, age 21 years, R/o Pipra village, Deoghar, Jharkhand.

M.O. OF THE OFFENDER:-

The Accused persons provided customer care number of the Lime Road App in Google website. Who ever calls them regarding issue/problem, the accused disconnects the call from that number and calls them from another phone number and in the process of how to cancel the order and get refund amount, they will sent message/link and ask them to forward to another number of their head office and obtain the UPI activation link of the victim and fraudulently transfers amounts from their bank accounts.

The team is headed by Sri D. Prashanth, Inspector of Police, Sri K. Satish Reddy, S.I. along with staff under the supervision of Sri K.V.M. Prasad, Asst. Commissioner of Police, Cyber Crime PS, Hyderabad, apprehended the accused persons.
