MARKET POLICE DETECTED THE MYSTERIOUS MUDER CASE OF UNKNOWN WOMAN AND ARRESTED THE ACCUSED

On 08.09.2020 at about 0930 hrs. an unknown female decomposed dead body with the features as aged in between 30-35 years, Wheatish complexion, 5'-4" height, Round Face, Flat Nose, and a green colour half moon figure with dots tattoo mark on the left hand wrist was found lying under suspicious circumstances in the unused public toilet situated under the Railway Bridge towards northern side of Bansilalpet Railway Bridge under the limits of Market Police Station.

Teams have been formed to establish the identity of the unknown deceased and the accused involved and subsequently, they got information through local person and caught the accused.

Interrogation of the accused revealed the name of the deceased as Smt. Bhoolakshmi w/o T. Srinivas, 40-years, Native of Prakasham District and the accused as Mangamuri Venkata Chennaiah s/o Venkataiah, 35-years, Labour Native of Prakasham District, temporarily residing in H.No. 7-3-448, Ghansmandi, Secunderabad as a tenant.

In the month of February, 2020 the accused came to Hyderabad for eking out his livelihood by doing labour work at the construction sites and staying in Parvathapuram, Uppal. About 5-months back he came in contact with the deceased who was found sitting alone in the Uppal Bus Stop. He took her to his rented room where they stayed for a couple of days and had sexual intercourse.

Later, the accused shifted to Ghansmandi, Secunderabad. About one month back the deceased again met the accused at his work place. Both were in the habit of consuming alcohol. The deceased took an amount of Rs. 5,000/- from the accused without his knowledge and left the place. After few days she again contacted the accused and started living with him in the rented room at Ghansmandi by doing labour work. On 06.09.2020 being Sunday they both stayed at home and at about 1100 hrs. the accused bought alcohol and chicken; they both consumed alcohol and had lunch and slept. Again the deceased Bhoolakshmi took an amount of Rs. 1,200/- from the accused without his knowledge went out consumed alcohol and came back to the room in the night in intoxicated condition and returned an amount of Rs. 500/- to the accused. As the deceased was in the habit of taking money from the accused without his knowledge, he disgusted with her attitude and picked up quarrel and brutally assaulted her causing injuries on her face and other parts of her body. At about 1930 hrs. the accused went to a Wine Shop situated at Bansilalpet Railway Bridge, where he hatched a plan to eliminate the deceased. He purchased alcohol, went back to his room and made the deceased to consume alcohol and kicked her brutally, as a result of which she fell down from the cot and the accused stood on her chest as a result of which she caused suffocation and oozing of blood from her nostrils. In the early hours of 07.09.2020 at about 0500 hrs the accused wake up and found the deceased dead. The accused concealed the dead body beneath the cot and moved freely to avoid suspicion duly locking the room from outside. In the night at about 2330 hrs. finding the area free from public movement, clad the deceased with yellow Lahenga, wrapped with a multi coloured blanket, lifted it on his shoulders and thrown it in the unused public toilets situated beneath Bansilalpet Railway track, went back to his room, changed his clothes, locked the room and moved lavishly.
