

**PD ACT INVOKED AGAINST SHAIK WAJEED @ CHOR WAJEED @ DAMRU WAJEED
S/O MOHD. HAJI, ROWDY SHEETER OF LANGER HOUSE POLICE STATION,

Sri Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City issued preventive detention order under Act No.1 of 1986 against Shaik Wajeed @ Chor Wajeed @ Damru Wajeed s/o Mohd. Haji, **Rowdy Sheeter of Langer House Police Station** on 29.12.2020.

Shaik Wajeed @ Chor Wajeed @ Damru Wajeed s/o Mohd. Haji, aged about 35 years, Occ: Milk/Vegetable business/Lorry driver & Cleaner, r/o H.No.9-7-285, MD Lines, Langer House, Hyderabad, **Rowdy Sheeter** of Langer House PS in the recent past committed 2 cases **of attempt to murder, criminal intimidation and extortion by using lethal weapons in public places in the limits of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate.**

He has **earlier committed 33 offences which include burglaries, outraging modesty of women, hurts and criminal intimidation in the limits of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate since 2001.** His activities are creating large scale fear, terror and panic among the public thereby adversely affecting the public order.

Langer House Police arrested the accused Shaik Wajeed @ Chor Wajeed @ Damru Wajeed on 26.9.2020 in Cr.No.170/2020 U/s 307, 384, 504, 506 IPC of Langer House PS. The Preventive Detention Order was executed on him on 30.12.2020 and he was lodged in Central Prison, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad.

Sri Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City issued preventive detention order under Act No.1 of 1986 against Mohd.Mashi Uddin @ Masi s/o Mohd.Gayasuddin, **rowdy sheeter** of Rein Bazar Police Station on 30.12.2020.

Mohd.Mashi Uddin @ Masi s/o Mohd.Gayasuddin, aged about 23 years, Occ: Clothes business at Patel market, r/o H.No.16-7-133 (181A), Azampura Chaman, Chaderghat, Hyderabad along with his associates **committed attempt to murder and murder in an organized manner in the limits of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate** and he has been creating large scale fear, terror and panic among the general public, thereby adversely affecting the public order, apart from disturbing the peace, tranquillity and social harmony in the society.

Rein Bazar Police arrested the detenu Mohd.Mashi Uddin @ Masi in Cr.No. 168/2020 u/s 302, 120-B, 506, r/w 34 IPC and Sec.25 (1) (b) of Arms Act of Rein Bazar Police Station on 19.8.2020 and remanded him to judicial custody. The preventive detention order was executed on him **on 31.12.2020** and he was lodged in Central Prison, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad.

The organs came by flight from Ahmedabad City.

The distance between Rajiv Gandhi International Airport, Shamshabad to KIMS Hospital, Begumpet, Hyderabad is **36.8 KMs** which was covered in **32 minutes**. The medical team carrying LIVE ORGAN (Lungs) left at **17:11 hrs** from RGI Airport, Shamshabad and reached KIMS Hospital, Begumpet, Hyderabad at **17:43 hrs**.

The efforts of Hyderabad and Cyberabad Traffic Police in the transportation of LIVE ORGAN (Lungs) were applauded by the management of KIMS Hospital, Begumpet, Hyderabad as it would help in saving precious lives. This year i.e., in 2021 Hyderabad Traffic Police has facilitated organ transport for the first time. In the year 2020 Hyderabad Traffic Police has facilitated organs transport 20 times. Hyderabad Traffic Police cares for our citizens.

- ➔ If they noticed that their mobile lost, immediately lock the cell phone through GOOGLE DEVICE MANAGER by logging through Gmail ID.
- ➔ Always keep ON the GPS/Location service to easy locating the fell down cell phones.
- ➔ Securing the IMEI numbers of their using cell phones.
- ➔ Handing over the traced cell phone in nearest Police Station to avoid misuse, as every cell phone can trackable and be a good citizen.
