

**PD ACT INVOKED AGAINST PULLETIKURTHI UMA MAHESHWAR RAO,  
BURGLAR OF OSMANIA UNIVERSITY PS, EAST ZONE, HYDERABAD**

Sri Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City issued preventive detention order under Act No.1 of 1986 against Pulletikurthi Uma Maheshwar Rao @ Mahesh @ Bujji s/o late Jaganmohan Rao, aged about 41 years, Occ: Goldsmith, r/o D.No.16-18-109-A, near Anjaneyaswamy temple, Burlevari Street, Old Guntur town, Guntur district of Andhra Pradesh, **“burglar” of Osmania University PS** on 17.4.2021.

He has been habitually committing burglaries in the limits of Hyderabad and Rachakonda Police Commissionerates along with his associates in an organized manner by frequently commuting to Hyderabad from Guntur district and temporarily staying in MGBS and also in a lodge at Secunderabad. He has been creating large scale fear and panic among the general public by committing such offences, and thus he has been acting in a manner prejudicial to the maintenance of public order, apart from disturbing the peace, tranquility and social harmony in the society.

Osmania University Police arrested the detenu Pulletikurthi Uma Maheshwar Rao on 5.2.2021 in Cr.No.12/2021 of Osmania University PS and remanded him to judicial custody. The preventive detention order was executed on him on 19.4.2021 and he was lodged in Central Prison, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad.
