On 13-11-2021 at 10.09 hrs Hyderabad Traffic Police arranged Green Channel for transportation of LIVE ORGAN (HEART & LUNGS) from Yashoda Hospital, Malakpet, Hyderabad to KIMS Hospital, Secunderabad.

The distance between Yashoda Hospital, Hyderabad to KIMS Hospital Secunderabad is 11 KMs which was covered in 12 minutes. The medical team carrying LIVE ORGAN (HEART & LUNGS) left at 10.09 hrs from Yashoda Hospital, Malakpet, Hyderabad and reached KIMS Hospital, Secunderabad, at 10.21 hrs.

**TRACED THE MYSTERY OF UNKNOWN GIRL DEAD BODY AND NABBED TWO
ACCUSED PERSONS BY PANJAGUTTA POLICE.**

Cr.No.511/2021, U/sec.302, 201 IPC of PS Panjagutta:

On 13.11.2021, the sleuths of Panjagutta Police, Hyderabad Police Commissionerate apprehended two accused:

Details of Deceased:

Baby Mehak, D/o. Mohd. Ahmed, Age: 04 years, R/o. H.No.3-555, New Hafeezpet, Aditya Nagar, Miyapur, Hyderabad.

Details of the accused:

A1] Shaik Mohd. Khadar @ Rizwan, S/o. Shaik Ahmed, Age: 25 years, Occ: Hotel Worker, R/o. H.No.17-6-197, Sunar Galli, Dabeerpura, Hyderabad.

A2] Heena Begum, W/o. Mohd. Ahmed, Age: 22 years, Occ: Housemaid, R/o. H.No.3-555, New Hafeezpet, Aditya Nagar, Miyapur, Hyderabad.

Facts of the case:

The accused A2 was married to one Ahmed and was blessed with one son **Affan, Age: 07 years and two daughters i.e., Maheak, Age: 04 years and Mahera, Age: 03 years** and the deceased is the elder daughter. The husband of A2 is a property offender who at present is under Judicial Custody in Cr.No.824/2021, U/sec. 392 IPC of PS Miyapur. A2 was going to toddy compound at Shaikpet where she got in touch with accused A1 and she shared her problems with him and he proposed to marry her and take care of her and her children. Later A1 took A2 along with deceased child and her son Affan with him to Mumbai, Delhi, Jaipur, Manali and were eking their livelihood by begging and were also making the children beg and A1 & A2 were in live in relationship.

As the deceased child was not happy with A1 being close to A2 and also was insisting to go back to her father and was also refusing to go for begging with them for which she was subjected to severe physical torture.

On 03.11.2021, while they were in Bengaluru the A1 & A2 bet the deceased severely by giving fist blows over her abdomen and also kicked with legs and A2 also beat her severely with hands and due to assault meted out by A1 & A2, the child became unconscious. Thereafter both the accused A1 & A2 got frightened and decided to come to Hyderabad and boarded a private bus. In the bus they noticed the body of the deceased having become cold and concluded that she has expired. To escape from the offence committed by them and also to disappear the evidence, brought the

deceased to Hyderabad to leave the dead body near the surroundings of NIMS Hospital as it will be assumed that some poor patient has left the dead body. Accordingly they left the dead body of the deceased on the footpath in front of H.No.6-3-347/23/1, Dwarakapuri Colony, Panjagutta, Hyderabad and escaped from there.

BUSTED ORGANIZED GAMING HOUSE & 09 HELD

On credible information the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, North Zone Team conducted raid at organized Gaming house situated at Flat no. 407, C block, RK Towers, Mayuri Marg in the limits of **Begumpet PS** and apprehended **(09) accused persons** in which two Gaming Organizers. Wherein the Gaming organizer Kota Rathaiah along with his associate Atun Guptha **organizing gambling** at above said premises by inviting punters, who are habit of playing three card gambling by betting money which is a game of chance and gain easy money illegally.

➤ **FACT OF THE CASE** :-

The accused Kota Rathaiah S/o. K.Kondaiah is residing in the limits of Begumpet, Secunderabad. He is habit of playing gambling by betting money and came into contact with his associate Atun Guptha S/o. S.E. Guptha and hatched a plane to organizing Gaming house situated at his associated house situated a Flat no. 407, C block, RK Towers, Mayuri Marg in the limits of **Begumpet PS** by inviting punters who are habit of playing three card game & Ander Bhahar game by betting money, which is a game of chance and collecting some amount from each punter for allowing them into their gaming house for playing gambling and gain illegal easy money .

On 13-11-2021 in the night hours while the gaming organizer Kota Rathaiah along with his associate Atun Guptha and punters are playing three card gambling by betting money, meanwhile on tip off the Commissioner's Task Force, North Zone team conducted raid above said premises and apprehended (09) accused persons including the Gaming organizers along with punters.

Seized betting amount **Rs. 69,380/-, 52 play cards & 10 Cell phones** from the possession of above accused persons.

The apprehended accused persons along with seized material handed over to SHO, Begumpet PS for taking necessary legal action against them as per law.

The apprehension was made under the supervision of **Sri. BUSTED ADULTERATED TEA POWDER MANUFACTURING UNIT - HELD ONE PERSON - SEIZED RAW MATERIAL OF TEA POWDER - TOTAL WORTH OF Rs: 6,00,000/-

The sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, South Zone Team, Hyderabad, along with Shahinayathgunj Police conducted joint operation and busted adulterated Tea Powder Manufacturing Unit at Feelkhana, Begum Bazar Hyderabad. Apprehended one person and seized Raw material of tea powder and other manufacturing equipment's

Name of the accused:-

- Vishnu Gopal Tiwari S/o late Jethmal Tiwari, age: 54 yrs, Occ: Proprietor of Srinath Agencies Tea Powder, R/o: Feelkhana, Begum Bazaar, Hyderabad

Seized objects:

- 1) 218 bags of tea powder raw material (Each bag weighing 35 kg's)
- 2) Two bags of adulterated tea powder Each bag weighing 20 kgs's
- 3) One bottle having the two litres of liquid chemical
- 4) One Mixer Machine
- 5) Two weighing machines
- 6) One Cartoon of Red Rose Tea Powder box each box 250 grams.

BRIEF FACTS:

Vishnu Gopal Tiwari is the residence of Feel Khana, Hyderabad. He established Sainath Agencies situated at Feel Khana, Goshamahal and running business of Tea Powder. Further, he is indulging in manufacturing the adulterated Tea powder by mixing it with different flavors and chemicals suspected to be (Tatrazine) for extra taste & color in tea powder. The same adulterated tea powder is packing in small 250 grams packets and different 5 KGs bags duly mentioning different names on the bags and selling to the shops in the name of Premium Red Rose Tea Powder, Dilkhush Ganesh Tea, Red Gulab, Tulsi Supreme Tea etc., without obtaining the FSSAI permission & license and not maintaining the food safety standards.

The chemical using in adulterated Tea power has been suspected of being the cause of many adverse reactions like., Urticaria, Asthma, Skin rashes, food intolerances ect., All consumers are advised to check the genuinity before purchase of any product.

The accused person along with seized material handed over to **SHO Shahinayathgunj PS** for further action.
