

**PD ACT INVOKED AGAINST VARAKALA NARSIMHA @ CHERPATA NARSIMHA  
S/O V.KRISHNA, ROWDY SHEETER OF KULSUMPURA POLICE STATION, WEST

Sri Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City issued preventive detention order under Act No.1 of 1986 against Varakala Narsimha @ Cherpata Narsimha s/o V.Krishna, Rowdy Sheeter of Kulsumpura Police Station on 3.11.2021.

Varakala Narsimha @ Cherpata Narsimha s/o V.Krishna, aged about 28 years, Occ: Worker in kamela, r/o H.No.13-3-1049/27, near Nalla Pochamma temple, Indiranagar, Jiyaguda, Hyderabad has committed 3 offences of habitually committing offences of voluntarily causing hurt, extortion and criminal intimidation in the limits of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate. His activities are creating large scale fear, terror and panic among the public, thereby adversely affecting the public order.

Earlier he committed 8 offences including murders in the limits of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate and he was detained under the Act No.1 of 1986 during the year of 2019.

Kulsumpura Police arrested Varakala Narsimha @ Cherpata Narsimha on 25.10.2021 in Cr.No.157/2021 u/s 384, 506 IPC of Kulsumpura PS. The Preventive Detention Order was executed on him on 5.11.2021 and he was lodged in Central Prison, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad.

Today i.e., on 15-11-2021 Hyderabad Traffic Police has filed 31 charge sheets of SR Nagar Tr. PS against 31 persons who were caught while driving their vehicles in drunken condition and produced them before the Hon'ble IV Metropolitan Magistrate Court, Nampally, Hyd.

The Hon'ble IV MM Court has awarded the following punishment for the violators.

- 1) For **2** persons punishment was given with a fine of Rs. 10,500/-. They were sent to Chanchalguda Jail for 5 days as they were caught **for 1st time** while driving vehicle in drunken condition.
- 2) For **29** persons punishment was given with a fine of Rs. 10,500/- who were caught **for 1st time** while driving vehicle in drunken condition.

Hyderabad Traffic Police requests the citizens to not to drive their vehicles in drunken condition and also it is informed that the respondents who were convicted in drunken drive may face difficulties in getting govt. jobs, passport and visa clearance. Hyderabad Traffic Police will continue this special drive on drunken drive to save the lives of Citizens.

**FALAKNUMA POLICE NABBED THE ACCUSED AND  
DETECTED THE MURDER CASE**

**Facts of Cr. No. 300/2021 U/s 120-B, 302 r/w 34 IPC & 27 (3) of Arms Act 1959  
of PS Falaknuma:**

On 13.11.2021 Mohd Arif @ Shoaib, Age: 32 Years, Occ: Mobile technician R/o H.No 19-3-528/1/47, Paeen bagh, Jahanuma, Falaknuma, Hyderabad was attacked by Amjad and others, at Payeenbagh, Jahanuma, Hyderabad. He was shifted OGH immediately at 2300 hrs he was declared dead at 0210 hrs of 14-11-2021. On that, a case U/s 302 r/w 34 IPC was registered and later altered to 120-B, 302 r/w 34 IPC & Sec. 27 (3) of Arms Act 1959 basing on the confessions of the accused.

A-1) Mohammed Sami Mohiuddin @ Sami S/o Late Mohammed Tanveer Mohiuddin, age 32 years, Occ: Home Guard at Hussaini Alam PS, R/o Salaheen colony, Nawab Saheb Kunta, Hyderabad

A-2) Mohammed Amjad Mohiuddin @ Amjad S/o Late Mohammed Tanveer Mohiuddin, age 25 years, Occ: Nil, R/o Salaheen colony, Nawab Saheb Kunta, Hyderabad

A-3) Mohammed Ali @ Ali S/o Mohammed Kausar Ali, age 21 years, Occ: Bike Mechanic, R/o Saleheen Colony, Nawab Saheb Kunta, Falaknuma, Hyderabad

A-4) Amer Mohammed Khan @ Amer @ Kaboothar S/o Zahoor Mohammed Khan, age 26 years, Occ: Garments business, R/o H. No. 19-3-263/A/72, Nawab Saheb Kunta, Achi Reddy Nagar, Hyderabad

**MOTIVE of CRIME:** The deceased is brother-in-law of A-4 i.e. the deceased and the wife of A-4 are own brother and sisters. The deceased Mohammed Arif @ Shoaib has a girl friend, who regularly falling sick. On the same issue, the deceased Mohammed Arif @ Shoaib was of the impression that his sister Shaheen Kausar, i.e. wife of A-4 along with A-4 is doing black-magic on his girl friend and further he demanded A-4 and for Rs. 2,00,000/- for treatment and also severely threaten him to see their end. A-4 hatched plan along with his own brother A-1 and his friends A-2 & A-3 to kill Arif. As per their plan on 13.11.2021 in the night hours at around 2300 hours A-1 to A-3 went to the house of the deceased at Payeen bagh, Jahanuma and A-3 attacked the deceased with Chilli powder and further A-1 & A-2 attacked him with Axe and Knife and killed him.

**APPREHENSION:** On 15.11.2021, Sri R. Devendar, Inspector of Police along with his team apprehended the accused and arrested them. The arrests were made under the supervision of Sri Mohd. Majeed, Asst. Commissioner of Police, Falaknuma Divn, by Sri R. Devendar, Inspector of Police, PS Falaknuma and his team.
