The distance between Kamineni Hospital LB Nagar to KIMS Hospital, Begumpet, Secunderabad is **17.06 KMs** which was covered in **15 minutes**. The medical team carrying LIVE ORGANS (**HEART & LUNGS**) left at **08.05 hrs** from Kamineni Hospital LB Nagar and reached KIMS Hospital, Secunderabad, at **08.20 hrs**.

NABBED NOTORIOUS HOUSE BURGLAR MANTHRI SHANKAR
ALONG WITH THREE ASSOCIATES

The sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, South Zone Team, Hyderabad along with Saidabad Police apprehended one notorious house burglar **Mantri Shankar** and along with his three associates namely 1) Syed Asad Khan 2) Syed Mehraj and 3) Syed Moiz and **detected (06) House breaking by night offences** in Hyderabad, Cyberabad and Rachkonda Commissionerates.

Details of accused person:-

- 3) **Syed Mehraj**, age. 32 yrs Occ: Auto Driver, Hafiz Baba Nagar, Hyderabad.
- 4) **Mohd Moiz Khan**, Age: 26 years, Near Ali Café, Amberpet, Hyderabad.

Brief facts:-

The accused Mantri Shankar, who is born and brought up in Chilkaiguda area of Hyderabad city is a notorious/habitual house burglar. To gain easy money he started committing offences since 1979. He has committed more than **260** house burglaries and theft cases in three Commissionerates. He convicted in 209 cases. Said

Manthi Shankar has been arrested more than 22 times since, 1979. A **CDC** sheet have been maintaining against him at Chilkalguda PS. As of now **(04) times he detained under PD Act**, two times by OU PS, one time from Saidabad PS, and one time from Karkhana PS. He **released from jail on 14/12/2021**. After releasing from jail he, formed a gang with three associates namely Syed Asad, Syed Mehraj and Moiz Khan and involved in house burglary offence.

A known face among police personnel and other criminals, the offender frequently shift his place of stay. He used Iron rod, Screw driver to break open the door locks and committed offences. Generally he commits offences in between 1 A.M to 4 A.M. Once he enters any locality for commission of offence, he moves from one house to other house by crossing over the compound walls of the houses to avoid police and locality people.

The apprehended accused along with recovered property handed over to the SHO Saidabad Police Station for taking further action against him.

Measures to revoke passports of NRIs who post hateful posts-

We will register cases and issue lookout notices-

Cybercrime cases- Faster investigation to secure punishments

Strict enforcement of Covid-19 protocol.

In the first video conference after taking charge as Hyderabad Police Commissioner, Sri. C.V.Anand IPS on Tuesday instructed officers to act strict on social media harassment. He said that those harassing people by morphing their photos and posting them on social media platforms with derogatory comments should be dealt with strictly. In addition to registering cases against those spreading fake news on social media, he expressed the desire for a speedy trial.

Speaking at the conference, which was attended by police officers of all departments including SHOs, ACsP, DCsP, Joint CsP, Sri. DS Chauhan IPS Additional CP L&O of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate, the commissioner directed the authorities on the precautions to be taken in case of cybercrime.

During this, several suggestions have been made on the course to be followed in the case of cybercrime including speedy investigation in cybercrime cases.

With instances of NRIs posting hateful and derogatory posts on social media platforms, the commissioner warned of registering cases against them apart from issuing lookout notices.

Their passports will be seized and visas too will be cancelled as per legal provisions, CP Hyderabad warned.

The commissioner further asked the officials to provide information regarding crimes and criminals to the sections and wings concerned from time to time.

The officials were also asked to identify criminals who are repeatedly committing the same offence and take action against them and prevent them from involving in crimes. This will help in deterring others who are inclined to commit offences.

If there are any doubts in any of the cases, the Legal Advisor should immediately give suggestions and resolve the cases expeditiously. The trial should be expedited and the criminals should be punished, he said.

Emphasizing that every police officer should make it a habit to take actions necessary on your own, the commissioner asked them not to wait for orders from superior officers in emergencies and utmost important incidents. Take the necessary technical assistance to gather evidence, he said.

The commissioner also clarified that the officers within the jurisdiction of every police station should act to do justice to the people and not give in to any injustice. Police officers should be as people expect them to be.

CP Hyderabad on Coronavirus -

In the wake of the rising number of Covid-19 cases, it is mandatory and important that the G.O released by the State government banning public meetings, conferences, or rallies, should be strictly implemented in Hyderabad.

The commissioner also suggested ensuring proper ventilation in every office and police station.

At religious places, we have to make sure that people are not crowded. Police need to be more vigilant in this regard, he said.

He also spoke to the community elders within the respective police station and asked them to explain the GO details released by the government regarding the regulations.
