The Orientation Course is aimed to impart knowledge on improving investigation Skills for successful Prosecution, Functional Verticals–SOP, important Case Laws of High Court & Supreme Court, investigation of Cyber Frauds, Hyderabad City Police Act, VVIP Security, Mob Psychology, Crowd Control, investigation of crime against women cases, traffic management, IT initiatives of Telangana State, usage of online applications, Personality Development, Conduct & CCA Rules etc.,

The course is using advanced training technology involving conduct of classes simultaneously in 5 different halls and with interactive mode

This course has even planned by the CP Hyd City to induct the PSIs into city police in a well prepared manner. All senior officers of city will be taking one class each minimum. ## **THREE-MEMBERS DRUG PEDDLING GANG HELD AND SEIZED 205 ml OF HASH OIL & 01 KG OF GANJA**

On 06-01-2022 the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, Central Zone Team, Hyderabad along with SR Nagar Police, on credible information raided one house situated behind Venkateshwara Swamy Temple, B.K. Guda, Hyderabad and apprehended three Drug peddlers by name **1.** Mohammed Akram Raza @ Akram, **2.** Manthathi Sai Sumanth @ Sai Sumanth and **3.** Boy Juvenile and seized **Hash Oil** weighing about **205 ml** in 41 small plastic boxes, **Ganja** weighing about **01 KG** from their possession.

### **Brief Facts:**

Acting on a tip off, the sleuths of Commissioners Task Force, Central Zone Team, Hyderabad, apprehended three persons who is in illegal possession of Narcotic Drug i.e., Hash Oil and Ganja behind Venkateshwara Swamy Temple, B.K. Guda, Hyderabad and seized **Hash Oil** weighing about **205 ml** in 41 small plastic boxes and **Ganja** weighing about **01 Kg** from their possession.

On enquiry it came to know that the accused Mohammed Akram Raza @ Akram, Manthathi Sai Sumanth @ Sai Sumanth and Boy Juvenile procured Narcotic substances Hash Oil and Ganja from Adilabad Dist. agency area. They are procuring and bring the Narcotic substances to city via Railways and Road Transport system clandestinely and selling the same to customers. They are selling small box of Hash Oil for about Rs. 2000/- to Rs. 2,500/- and Ganja small packet for about Rs. 300/- to 400/- as such gaining illegal profits. On further enquiry it is came to know that the accused Manthathi Sai Sumanth @ Sai Suman is wanted in Cr. No. 02/2022 U/sec 20 (b)(ii)(A) of NDPS Act of Nampally PS, Hyderabad.

The arrested accused along with seized property were handed over to SHO, SR Nagar PS, for further investigation.

Today (7.1.2022) Sri. CV Anand IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City. conducted a surprise inspection in the office of the old Commissioner of Police - Purani Haveli in South Zone. After taking charge as the Hyderabad City Police Commissioner last month, Sri CV Anand conducted a surprise inspection of the Panjagutta Model Police Station. Similarly, the CP Hyderabad inspected the DCP South Zone, Task Force, and Special Branch offices in the old Police Commissioner's office for about 2 hours today. The Complaints received from visitors, such as the command and control center, help desk, and parking were examined.
