

PRESS RELEASE

The Cyber Crime Police, CCS, DD, Hyderabad City arrested one accused person namely Mr Cabral Edmondo @ Bright @ Shakha, S/o Edmondo, Age: 34 years, Occ: Barber, R/o H no. C-7, First Floor, Vikas Vihar, Sector 15, Kakrola, Dwaraka, Delhi, N/o Guinea Bissau, Africa who is involved in a Matrimonial fraud case.

On 14.02.2022, received a complaint from a woman residing in Old Bowenpally, Hyderabad, stating that she registered her details on a matrimonial site to remarry and she got a request from a person named Mr. Krishna Kumar, a resident of Scotland, U K. His phone number is +447938415512. After chatting for few days on whatsapp he told that he is going to visit India to see her and her family so that they can discuss the matter further and get married. Accordingly he told that he booked the flight ticket on 07-02-2022 from Glasgow, Scotland and told that he landed at Delhi Airport on 08-02-2022 and then victim got a call from +91879815**** stating that the airport authorities has seized his luggage as he bought huge amount of pounds with him and the authorities are asking them to pay some amount so that they can release him with some kind of clearance certificate. He asked her to make the payment on his behalf as he doesn't know anyone in India and the amount for clearance will be accepted only in Indian rupees so he asked the victim to pay as he has come to see you. Believing him she transferred total an amount of Rs 10,65,000/-. They also threatened her that if she don't pay the amount she will be also in trouble because of him. Then the complainant realized that she have been cheated and lodged the complaint. Vide FIR No. 228/2022 U/s 66 C, D ITA Act and 419, 420 IPC.

M.O. OF THE OFFENDER:

The accused, Africa national Mr Cabral Edmondo used to create fake accounts in different matrimonial portals with different names of good looking persons residing in foreign countries. Whenever any lady uploads her details in the matrimonial sites, he shows interest to marry the ladies who are also searching for the grooms and later when the victims shows interest he attains the attention of the victims and later he tells the victims that he is sending a parcel containing foreign currency, gold ornaments or that he was stucked in the airport etc. and extracts amounts in lakhs to deliver the parcel/luggage.

The team is headed by Sri Ch, Gangadhar, Inspector of Police, SIs Santa Rao, Tirupati, PCs Sunil, Narsing under the supervision of K.V.M. Prasad, Asst. Commissioner of Police, Cyber Crime PS, Hyderabad cracked the case.

Precautions to General Public:

Public are cautioned not to proceed without proper verification of their genuineness in matrimonial sites and don't transfer funds/amounts in advance responding to delivery of parcels.

**ONE GOLD CHAIN SNATCHER HELD - SEIZED ONE TWO-WHEELER,
RECOVERED 47 GRAM OF GOLD CHAIN**

On 10-06-2022, on credible information the Commissioner's Task force, **Central Zone Team**, Hyderabad, apprehended one accused who has committed Gold Chain Snatching in the limits of Chikkadpally PS, Hyderabad and recovered stolen property i.e., snatched Gold Chain and also seized crime vehicle which was used in the commission of offence.

Modus Operandi:

The accused Vaddy Shiva Kumar @ Shiva is native of Hyderabad. He studied up to 10th class. Later he discontinued his further studies due to disinterest and started working as a labour. After that he started working as sand supplier and eking livelihood for his family. Later due to family issues his earnings became insufficient and he was facing financial problems. As such the accused Vaddy Shiva started Chain Snatchings to get easy money. In the month of December 2021, he was first involved in chain snatching case vide **Crime No.326/2021 U/s 392 of PS Nallakunta and arrested by the Nallakunta Police.**

Likewise, on 06-06-2022 as per his plan while moving near Venakateshwara High School, Chikkadpally area he found one lady who was moving near Jewellery Lane, Chikkadpally and targeted her and snatched her Gold Chain from her neck and fled away from the spot on his Activa vehicle. As per the compliant of the victim lady Smt. Smt. Raparathi Savitha W/o P. Satyanarayana, age: 52 years, occ: Housewife, R/o:1-8-430/7/7/1, Jewellery lane, Chikkadpally, Hyderabad, a case

was registered in Chikkadpally PS vide **Cr. No. 193/2022 U/s 392 IPC on 06-06-2022.**

On a credible information the Commissioner's Task Force, Central Zone Team, Hyderabad, apprehended the accused and recovered Gold chain weighing about 47 Grams, Activa Vehicle and one mobile phone.

The apprehended snatcher along with recovered property were handed over to SHO, Chikkadpally PS for further investigation.

GOPALAPURAM POLICE NABBED NOTORIOUS INTER STATE GANG (06) MEMBERS AND SEIZED 43.25 TULAS OF GOLD ORNAMENTS, 27 TULAS OF SILVER AND NET CASH OF RS. 4,13,000/- ALL WORTH RS. 26,50,000/-

Today i.e. on 10.06.2022 wee hours, Gopalpauram police on credible information apprehended **(06) Persons Ishaq, Mohd Gulshed, Mohd Juned Aalam, Abdul Ansar Ali, Riyasad and Bablu Ahmad** at In-gate of Secunderabad Railway Station, who were moving under suspicious manner and on enquiry they voluntarily confessed their guilty in the below mentioned (07) cases.

MODUS OPERANDI:

The gang, on the pretext of Garments business used to travel from one place to another place by RTC/Pvt Buses as passengers, observe the luggage bags of passengers, target the bags, while passenger is on other work some of the accused persons cover the passenger then the main accused break or remove the bag zip,

commit theft of Cash, Gold, valuables from the luggage bags of passengers and get down in the next stage.

While going to commit offence they carry bags to mislead the victims. Gang organizer engages associates for Rs. 2,000/- to 5,000/- for assistance in committing offence. They change associates frequently to avoid identity from victims. The Gang members take shelter in nearby lodges and rented rooms after committing the offence and on the next day again they move out to commit another offence.
