The Khairatabad Ganesh Utsav Samithi members were felicitated by the city police commissioner Mr.CV Anand and GHMC commissioner Mr Lokesh for deciding to make the Khairatabad Ganesh idol with clay and organic colours this year. Appreciating their move, CP said that clay idols are pro environment and appealed to the public to emulate the same and to celebrate the festival in a most eco-friendly and grand manner.

The GHMC and the city police contemplates to hold training programme on making clay idols during Vinayaka Chaturthi celebrations. During the meeting, which took place at the CP office, HCP Chief Mr.Anand along with GHMC commissioner Mr.Lokesh Kumar sought the views of the Utsav samithi members on how they plan to organise the festival celebration.

CP also assured that all possible help will be provided to Khairatabad Ganesh Ustav Samithi at all levels and urged them to set up proper barricading system in quelines and illuminate the entire area for the convenience of the devotees. "Our officers will be stationed to tackle any situation. Traffic wing will monitor all the routes abutting to the idol site and towing vehicles will be pressed into service to clear the vehicles blocking the carriage way. Even the rail track near the pandal will be monitored." he said.

"GHMC is making elaborate arrangements including road repairs, pothole filling, addressing water stagnation, LED lighting and other issues. From our end, we will distribute 5 lakh clay idols. If we create an awareness among so many people then our message will surely penetrate further." Said GHMC Commissioner Mr.Lokesh Kumar.

Long pending civic works have been pointed out, to which the GHMC Commissioner assured that they would be completed before the festival.

"The Khairatabad Ganesh idol is one of the most popular Ganesh pandals in the country and we want to do our bit for the environment. This year, the gigantic idol will be 50 feet tall and the work has commenced at full pace." Said Sudarshan, founder & chairman of Khairatabad Ganesh Utsava Samithi.

PRESS NOTE

Hyderabad Traffic Police will conduct a special drive for ensuring the safety and security of the Citizens from 18-06-2022 onwards against Tinted Glass / fixing black films on window glasses of cars, moving without/irregular registration no plate, having temporary registration plate even after one month of purchase etc. as these offences are observed to be contributors of, not only traffic violations, but also criminal activities.

In this regard Hyderabad Traffic police wish to create awareness on rules and regulations incorporated in Motor Vehicles Act and Rules, with regards to registration of No Plates, Temporary registration number plates and Tinted Glass (Wind Shield & Rear window & both sides windows).

I. SAFETY GLASSES/WIND SHIELDS: CMV Rule 100: The vehicle owners shall ensure that the windscreen and rear window of every motor vehicle that the visual transmission of light is not less than 70%. The glasses used for side windows are such and shall be maintained in such condition that the visual transmission of light is not less than 50%.

II. REGISTRATION NUMBER PLATES: CMV Rule 50, 51: The vehicle owners shall fix proper number plate on their vehicles as per the guidelines under rules 50, 51 of CMV Rule-1989 only.

III. TEMPORARY REGISTRATION NUMBER PLATE: MV Act Section 43: The temporary registration made under this section will be valid only for a period not exceeding one month and shall not be renewable. The vehicle owner shall get registered his vehicle, obtain permanent register number and fix the registration number plate according to rules 50 and 51 of CMV Rule, 1989.

Citizens are requested to abide by the above rules and regulations and guidelines. If any vehicle found violating the above rules and regulations a legal action will be initiated against the driver as well as against the owner of the vehicle as per law under Motor Vehicles Act and also the provisions of Sec. 188 I.P.C. (Indian Penal Code) and Sec 21 of Hyderabad City Police Act 1348F. **Commission of violations of II & III, the errant drivers/owners of the vehicles will be prosecuted in the Hon'ble court of Law after filing charge sheets against them.**

Investigation reveals that A1 to A3 who are close friends and A-1 Macherla Srikanth is addicted to bad habits, lavish life, to fulfil his desires, to earn easy money used to commit parked two-wheeler thefts only Splendor, Passion, Galmour, Shine bikes as they are very easy to unlock by using false key, in the midnight, early morning hours when public in deep sleep in residential areas. Since 2020 A-1 committed theft of two-wheeler vehicles, from different areas of Hyderabad, Cyberabad & Rachakonda commissionerates, for disposal of two wheeler vehicles he used to give them to his friends A-2 Ganesh and A-3 Satu Srisailam @ Tillu for a lesser price and to sale in rural areas i.e. Shadnagar, Chowlapally, Keshampet etc. A2 and A3 sale the vehicles to the needy customers in the pretext of the vehicles has been seized by financiers, soon they will arrange the vehicle documents to legalize.
