Brief facts of the case.

Brief Facts of the case are that today i.e., on 24.01.2024 at 02:30 hrs received English written complaint from Smt. Kurva Geetha W/o Mallesh, age: 26 Yrs Occ: Agriculture, R/o Erla Dinee(V), Narva (M), Narayanpet (Dist). Ph. No. 8309999860. In which she stated that she is pregnant of 9 months. Admitted two and half weeks back. She came to Maternity Hospital, Petlaburj near Judge Khana, Hyderabad for medical checkup and delivery along with her son K. Shiva Kumar Age: 6 yrs. Yesterday i.e., on 23-01-2024 at about 1630 hrs she was inside the hospital and his son Shiva Kumar was playing outside few minutes, later when she came out side. She found missing of her son. She searched all the hospital surroundings area but in vain. Some unknown persons might have kidnapped her son. Hence she request to take necessary action as per law.

On 30-01-2024 at 1200 hrs, the LW- affected the arrest of accused person A-1 Orusu Venkanna S/o Orusu Srinu, age: 30 yrs, Occ: Labour, R/o: Pedamberpet, Hyderabad N/o Haliya (V), Anmula (m), Nalgonda(D). Ph no: 8340870567 and A-2 Orusu Kavitha S/o Orusu Venkanna, age: 26 yrs, Occ: Labour, R/o: Pedamberpet, Hyderabad N/o Haliya (V), Anmula (m), Nalgonda (D). Ph no: 8340870567, by issuing arrest memo, duly informing the grounds of their arrest. Arrest intimation was given to his kith and kin under proper acknowledgement.

The investigation done established that the accused A-1 Orsu Venkanna native of Haliya (V), Anmula (m), Nalgonda (D). came to Hyderabad (05) months ago and staying at Pedda Amberpet Village and he is eking livelihood by doing labour work at Hayat Nagar, since he is blessed with three daughters he was eagerly waiting to adopt

a male child to fulfill his family desire, Later A-1 Orsu Venkanna met with one Darshanam Raju at his work place and shared his views of having male baby and the above said Raju promised A-1 Orsu Venkanna that he will adopt a male child for that he will be expecting one lakh rupees for the work, later the accused A-1 Orsu Venkanna accepted the deal and agreed to pay sixty thousand rupees to Darshanam Raju after adopting the child only.

On 30-01-2024 at 1630 hrs, the A-1 Orsu Venkanna, A-2 Orsu Kavitha along with Darshanam Raju and his wife Kamma came to Hyderabad Government Maternity Hospital, Petlaburz, while the victim Shiva Kumar who was playing outside his mother Kurva Geetha who was inside the Hospital, they lured the victim boy by showing chocolates after the victim boy came near them slowly without knowing to anyone they eloped the him and immediately they went to Pedda Amberpet.

On information, the sleuth of Hussainialam Police apprehended the accused persons A-1 & A-2 along with Victim Boy Shiva Kumar age 6 years, at Hayat Nagar Labour Adda.

TRAFFIC ADVISORY

In view of the Staff Nurse Recruitment Programme at LB Stadium on **31.01.2024**, the following traffic restrictions are likely to be implemented from **1200 hrs to 1900 hrs**.

The traffic will be either stopped or diverted at the following places/routes on need basis:

1. Traffic coming from AR Petrol Pump Jn. (Public Gardens) towards BJR Statue will not be allowed and will be diverted at A.R. Petrol Pump towards Nampally.
2. Traffic coming from Basheerbagh towards A.R. Petrol Pump will not be allowed and will be diverted at BJR Statue towards, SBH, Abids- Nampally station road.
3. Traffic coming from Sujatha School lane towards Khan Lateef Khan building will not be allowed and will be diverted at Sujatha School junction towards Nampally.

Junctions to be avoided where traffic congestion is expected between 1200 hrs to 1900 hrs. on 31-01-2024:

Panjagutta, VV Statue, Rajiv Gandhi Statue (Monappa), Nirankari, Old PS Saifabad, Lakdikapool, Iqbal Minar, Ravindra Bharathi, Hyderabad Traffic Police Junction, Basheerbagh, BJR Statue Circle, SBI Gunfoundry, Abids Circle, A.R. Petrol Pump (Public Gardens), Nampally, KLK Building, Liberty, Himayath Nagar, Assembly, MJ Market and Hyderguda.

RTC Buses:

The RTC Buses plying from Ravindra Bharathi towards BJR Statue should avoid L.B. Stadium main Gate i.e. in front of Khan Lateef Khan Building and take diversion at A.R. Petrol (Public Gardens) bunk towards Nampally.
