

## <u>Illegal Sand Transportation- Special Operation by Hyderabad City</u> <u>Police from 14th February to 19th February 2025.</u>

The Telangana government has recently intensified its efforts to combat illegal sand mining and transportation within the state. In accordance with the orders of the Honorable Chief Minister of Telangana, the Hyderabad City Police, under the supervision of Sri C.V. Anand, IPS, DG, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, conducted significant operations against illegal sand transportation from February 14, 2025 to February 19, 2025.

During this period, the Hyderabad City Police registered a total of (26) cases related to the illegal extraction and transportation of sand across the Hyderabad city. In the course of these operations, (08) vehicles involved in the illegal activities were seized and (57) accused individuals were arrested and a total of (1196) tons of illegally transported sand was seized.

The Hyderabad City Police remains committed to maintaining law and order and will continue to take stringent action against illegal activities, including unauthorized sand transportation. We urge citizens to report any suspicious activities to the nearest police station or Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City.

## 247 WERE CAUGHT RED HANDED BY SHE TEAMS AT NAMPALLY EXHIBITION MISBEHAVING WITH WOMEN

*Hyderabad, 19<sup>th</sup> ,February 2025*: SHE Teams of Hyderabad City Police have successfully apprehended 247 offenders red-handedly at the Nampally Exhibition (Numaish) 2025, held from Jan 03 to Feb17 reinforcing their commitment to ensuring public safety, especially for women and children.,

Among the 247 red handed Cases, 37 petty cases were booked out of which 02 offenders received 2-day convictions and 33 offenders were fined ₹1,050/- each., 01 offender was fined ₹50/-., 01 offender was sentenced to 2 days of simple imprisonment along with a ₹50/- fine.,190 individuals were warned and let off after counseling., 20 cases are pending for disposal., Among the 247 offenders, 223 were majors and 24 were minors.
