"Oka Goppa Marpunaku Ide Sreekaram" (This is the Commencement of a Great Change) Program Launched to Impart Skill Development Training to Hyderabad City Police

Director General of Police Sri B. Sivadhar Reddy inaugurated the program

Hyderabad: Director General of Police Sri B. Sivadhar Reddy launched a large-scale skill development training program for the Hyderabad City Police titled **"Oka Goppa Marpunaku Ide Sreekaram" (This is the Commencement of a Great Change)**. DGP participated in the inauguration of this training program, held on Tuesday at the TGICCC Auditorium, Banjara Hills, Road No.12, Hyderabad along with Hyderabad CP Sri V. C. Sajjanar. On this occasion, they unveiled copies of the training material.

The main objective of this training program is to enhance the skills of the police personnel and provide better services to the public. A total of **19,488 personnel** across the Hyderabad Commissionerate jurisdiction will be trained in phases. This marks the **first time** in the history of the Hyderabad City Police that such a training program has been conducted for all staff.

178 Special Trainers have been selected to train the field-level staff. This group includes 74 ACPs, 98 Inspectors / Reserve Inspectors, and 6 Sub-Inspectors. A **Training of Trainers (ToT)** program was conducted for all of them. These trainers will, in turn, impart training to the personnel within their respective divisions.

DGP Sri B. Sivadhar Reddy's Address;

Speaking at the event, DGP Sri B. Sivadhar Reddy emphasized the need for everyone to **reskill** themselves in line with the evolving nature of policing. He stated that training plays a crucial role in an employee's life, and many new things can be learned through it. He explained that public awareness has increased compared to the past, and police behaviour needs to change accordingly. He expressed hope that this training would help further build public trust in the police system. He commended Hyderabad CP Sri V. C. Sajjanar for the excellent idea and for organizing the skill development training for all personnel under the name "Oka Goppa Marpunaku Ide Sreekaram."

Hyderabad CP Sri V. C. Sajjanar's Address;

Hyderabad CP Sri V. C. Sajjanar stated that training is essential for the development of any organization and its staff. He mentioned that this training would not only enhance skills but also help bring everyone onto the **same platform**. He noted that the program is being launched with good planning after a month-long preparation. He stated that the training is designed to transform every individual into an efficient and responsible police officer, expressing optimism that it will guide them toward the future while learning from the past.

He advised the staff to remember that their **behaviour and performance** are what enhance the prestige of the Police force.
