

HELD SIX PERSONS – SEIZED ONE COUNTRY MADE FIRE ARM AND (3) LIVE ROUNDS

On 27-12-2018, on credible information the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone Team, Hyderabad apprehended (6) accused persons who were found in possession of one Country made fire arm i.e. Pistol at Shivaji Nagar, Ranigunj, Sec'bad. Recovered **(1) Country made fire arm i.e. Pistol and (3) Live Rounds.**

Details of the accused persons:-

- 1) Hussain Gyas Mohammed Khan S/o Gyas Mohammed Manbaran Khan, aged 18 yrs, Occ: Auto driver.
- 2) P.Prakash S/o P.Balya Naik, aged 21 yrs, Occ: Tiles work.
- 3) J.Mohan S/o J.Laxman, aged 23 yrs, Occ: Mobile repairing work.
- 4) Narender Chowdary S/o Kukaram Chowdary, aged 26 yrs, Occ: Owner of Ajay Jewelers, Kulaka charla, Parigi, Vikarabad District.
- 5) Nemi chand S/o Kalunam Jatt, aged 28 yrs, Occ: Working in "Siddi Vinayak Silver", Pot market, Sec'bad.
- 6) Ganpat Jatt S/o Ramlal Jatt, aged 21 yrs, Occ: Working in "Vishwanath Jewelers", Pot Market, Sec'bad.

Brief history of accused persons:-

The accused Hussain Gyas Mohammed Khan is native of Chabra District of Bihar State. When he was in childhood his parents shifted to Sutardara, Shivkalyan Nagar, Adastha Society, Street No.13, Kothrud, Pune. At present he is working as Auto driver at Kothrud, Pune.

The accused P.Prakash is native of Govindpally(V), Salkarpet (Post), Gandvedu(M), Mahaboob Nagar District. About 20 years back his family shifted to Sutardara, Shivkalyan Nagar, Kothrud, Pune. About six months back he along with his family members shifted to Hyderabad for livelihood. When he was staying in Sutardara, Kothrud, Pune he developed friendship with the accused Hussain Gyas Mohaammed Khan.

The accused J.Mohan is native of Makthavenkatapur Thanda, Kulaka charla, Parigi, Vikarabad District. In the year 2016 he came to Hyderabad for his livelihood by residing at Kismathpur, Hyderabad. At present he is doing mobile repairing work at Kismathpur. The accused P.Prakash and J.Mohan belongs to ST community. They both became friends in marriage at Mahaboob Nagar and developed friendship with each other.

The accused Narender Chowdary is native of Sojat Road, Awalavas, Pali District, Rajasthan. In the year 2007 he came to Hyderabad for livelihood and worked in Jewelry shop styled as "Nakoda Jewelers" at Kukatpally. In the year 2014 he went to Kulaka charla, Parigi, Vikarabad District and started business on the name of "Ajay Jewelers" at Kulaka charla. About four years back he came into contact with the accused J.Mohan and both developed friendship with each other.

The accused Narender Chowdary, Nemi chand and Ganpat Jatt became friends while working in Nakoda Jewelers, Kukatpally, Hyderabad and developed friendship with each other.

Facts of the Case:-

The accused Hussain Gyas Mohammed Khan is working as Auto driver at Kothrud, Pune. But his earnings are not sufficient to meet lavish expenses. As such he hatched a plan to sell country made fire arms i.e. Pistols on high rates by procuring from Bihar.

About three months back he went to Bihar and purchased one country made fire arm i.e. Pistol and (3) live rounds from Uday Pandey @ Pandit, R/o Bihar and kept with him. Later he informed the accused P.Prakash who is his childhood friend that he is having one Pistol and (3) live rounds and planning to sell the same in Hyderabad for better profits and asked to get prospective customers to purchase the same from him and promised to give some amount as commission to him. The accused Prakash brought Pistol from Pune and handed over to J.Mohan at Hyderabad. The accused J.Mohan informed the same to his friend Narender Chowdary and asked to get prospective customers to purchase Pistol from them on commission basis.

Later the accused Narender Chowdary handed over the weapon along with (3) live rounds to accused Nemi chand to keep with him and informed to get customers to purchase the same. The accused Nemi chand kept the Pistol and (3) live rounds in his room at Shivaji Nagar, Ranigunj, Sec'bad. He shown the Pistol to the accused Ganpat Jatt and all the accused persons are waiting for prospective customers to purchase the Pistol and (3) live rounds from them on higher rate.

Today i.e. on 27-12-2018 the accused persons Hussain Gyas Mohammed Khan, P.Prakash, J.Mohan and Narender Chowdary came to Shivaji Nagar, Ranigunj, Sec'bad and met with the accused persons Nemi chand and Ganpat Jatt in Nemi chand's room and while discussing about selling of weapon, on credible information the West Zone Task Force team apprehended all the accused persons and seized one Country made Fire Arm i.e. Pistol and (3) live rounds from them.

Hence, the (6) accused persons along with the recovered property were handed over to SHO, Market PS, Hyderabad, for taking further action.

The arrests were made under the supervision of **Sri P.Radha Kishan Rao**, Dy.Commissioner of Police, Commissioner's Task Force, by **Sri B.Gattu Mallu**, Inspector of Police, Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone team, SI's Sri P.Mallikarjun, Sri L.Bhaskar Reddy, Sri Md.Mujaffar Ali and the staff of West Zone Team, Commissioner's Task Force.

NZTF TEAM BUSTED ORGANIZED HI-TECH CRICKET BETTING GANG -
(03) HELD

On credible information the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, North Zone Team conducted raid in the limits of Chikkadpally PS and busted organized Cricket betting gang and apprehended **(03) Cricket bookies** by name **1) Alok Jain 2) Abhishek Jain, 3) Mehul K. Morjaria** who are organizing hi-tech cricket betting and collecting money. Seized Total **Net Cash 41,20,000/-** (Rupees Forty one lakh and twenty thousand), **Televisions-01, Set top box-01, Cell phones-06**, from the instance of above accused persons.

3. Mehul K Morjaria S/o. Kirti Kumar Morjaria, age. 35 yrs, occ. Share marketing).

BRIEF FACTS OF THE CASE:-

The main betting organizer Alok Jain resident of Himayath Nagar, Hyderabad is a businessman. Initially he was involved in cricket betting as a punter under various cricket bookies and gain knowledge about the cricket betting. Later he decided to become cricket bookie. For organizing the cricket betting he took a rented **house situated at Flat No.202, 2nd floor Aysola Enclave, H.No: 1-1-342/4/A, Vivek nagar, Chikkadpally, opposite labor office, Hyderabad** and later he explained his plan to his brother Abhishek Jain and friend Mehul K. Morjaria to assist in the betting and himself identified interested punters.

In the year 2017 during IPL time he came into contact with main cricket betting organizers **Suleman Surani** and **Subhash**, who are the main bookies came into oral contract, to work under him by giving line and guidance and tips in cricket betting, sharing benefits with them.

Then Alok Jain became the prime cricket betting organizer in and around Hyderabad and organizing cricket betting and collecting betting amount from punters during ongoing Cricket matches i.e International One day matches, T20 Series, IPL match and Big Bash league series and gaining illegal money. Under the guide lines of International hi-tech cricket bookies Suleman Surani (presently organizing cricket betting from USA) and Subhash R/o Rajasthan with the active assistance of Abhishek Jain and Mehul K. Morjaria.

For this purpose the main bookies are using online website **www.msa.abexch.com** (**AB Exchange/LC Exchange**) and accepting betting amounts directly, indirectly and over cell phones, whatsapp messages from the punters during the Big Bash league 2018-19 T20 matches, playing at Australia and Test Matches between India and Australia which is a game of chance to gain illegal money. The bookies are paying Commission to main-bookies in order to collect the betting amount from punters.

The Main bookie Alok Jain sends login id and password to Mehul K. Morjaria through Whatsapp to login into main betting page in www.abexch.com(Master) using the login id and password Mehul K. Morjaria logs into the main betting page and creates the User id and passwords and provides to punters. With that user ids and passwords the punters used to bet on the cricket match.

In **T20 cricket matches** bookies divided the 20 overs into four sessions and bookies usually bet on the following:

- 1. Who will win toss(which team will win toss)**
- 2. Favourite Team(which team will win match)**
- 3. Individual player(Batsman scoring runs)**
- 4. Individual player(Bowler taking wickets)**
- 4. First session 6 overs(On score)**
- 5. Second session 10 overs**
- 6. Third session 15 overs**
- 7. Fourth session 20 overs**

ARREST:-

During the **T20 Big Bash league** 2018-19 playing in Australia, the bookies were collecting huge betting amounts from punters directly and indirectly during the matches, today i.e on **27-12-2018**, acting on a tip off, the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, North Zone Team, Hyderabad along with local police raided the betting premises **situated at Flat No.202, 2nd floor Aysola Enclave, H.No: 1-1-342/4/A, Vivek nagar, Chikkadpally, opposite labor office, Hyderabad** under the limits of Chikkadpally PS while **accepting the cricket betting** for match between Sydney Sixers vs Melbourne Stars, Big Bash League 2018-19 at Sydney Cricket Stadium and Test match between India and Australia at Melbourne Cricket Stadium, and apprehended three accused persons who are organizing hi-tech cricket betting and **Seized Net Cash 41,20,000/- (Rupees Forty one lakh and twenty thousand)**, Samsung TV set-01, Set tops box -01, Cell phones-06 from the instance of above accused persons.

The apprehended accused persons along with seized material are being handed over to **SHO, Chikkadpally PS** for further investigation.

The above accused persons were apprehended only due to the sincere and dedicated efforts of the Commissioner's Task Force, Hyderabad, headed by Sri **P. Radhakishan Rao, Dy. Commissioner of Police, Commissioner's Task Force**, Hyderabad assisted by Sri K. Nageswar Rao, Inspector of Police, Commissioner's Task Force, North Zone, and SIs Sri K.S. Ravi, Sri B. Parmeshwar and team of the North Zone Task Force, with the assistance of local police, Hyderabad.

Sri Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City issued a preventive detention order under the Act No.1 of 1986 against Guvvala Pavan Kumar @ Billa Pavan S/o Srinivas, aged about 25 years, **Rowdy Element**, on 30.11.2018.

The accused Guvvala Pavan Kumar @ Billa Pavan S/o Srinivas has been **indulging in a series of offences of extortion and criminal intimidation in public places in the limits of Hyderabad and Cyberabad Police Commissionerates** to make easy money and to lead lavish life.

He has committed 4 offences and has been creating large scale fear and panic among the general public and acting in a manner prejudicial to the maintenance of public order apart from disturbing the peace, tranquillity and social harmony in the society.

SR Nagar Police made strenuous efforts and arrested the accused Guvvala Pavan Kumar @ Billa Pavan on 4.9.2018 in Cr.No.643/2018 U/s 324, 506 r/w 34 IPCn of SR Nagar PS and remanded him to judicial custody. The preventive detention order was executed on him on 17.12.2018 and was lodged him in Central Prison, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad.
