

PRESS NOTE ON OPERATION SMILE -V 2019

Operation Smile - V for tracing missing children was launched on 01.01.2019. This is a month long programme to trace missing children and rescue child labour, children engaged in begging etc. In Hyderabad City 17 teams were constituted each headed by a SI. In the city so far 325 children have been rescued including 11 girls. Of these 53 children have been admitted in rescue homes while 272 have been handed over to their parents. 7 of the rescued children were below 10 years of age, 38 were between 11-14 years while 280 children were between age of 14-18 years. During this operation, 14 cases have been booked against various establishments for engaging child labour. Further a fine amount of Rs. 6,75,365 was imposed on establishments for various violations. The rescued children were found working in different types of establishments/factories like those engaged in making Bags, Bangles, Biscuits, Bakery, electrical items, mechanic shops, computer work, fabrications, welding shops, tiffin centres etc.

Besides rescuing children belonging to Hyderabad & Telangana, 100 children belonging to other states like A.P, Bihar, Jharkhand, U.P. and even Nepal were rescued during this operation. The Darpan app was used for checking the details of children with the database. Taking a humane approach the city police on its own initiative admitted 3 of these children in schools. Two of these children had dropped out from school due to family reasons and were found wandering on the streets. They have been admitted in different schools in Secunderabad & were provided uniform & books by S.I. Rajini of Trimulgherry PS.

Further, one boy of 10 years was working in electrical shop due to financial problem. He showed interest in joining to school and ASI Rafiuddin of Golconda P.S. took initiative and got him admitted in a school at Tappachabutra.

We are grateful to the management of the 3 schools who have agreed to provide free education to these children.

**PD ACT INVOKED AGAINST V NAGARAJU SNATCHER OF SR NAGAR PS,
WEST ZONE, HYDERABAD**

Sri Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City issued preventive detention order against V Nagaraju **Snatcher of SR Nagar PS** on 22.12.2018 under the provision of Act No.1 of 1986.

The accused V Nagaraju **has been indulging in a series of offences of snatchings and extortion in the limits of Hyderabad and Cyberabad Police Commissionerates** to make easy money and to lead lavish life.

He has committed 6 offences and has been creating large scale fear and panic among the general public and acting in a manner prejudicial to the maintenance of public order apart from disturbing the peace, tranquillity and social harmony in the society.

SR Nagar Police made strenuous efforts and arrested the accused V Nagaraju on 29.10.2018 in Cr.No.793/2018 u/s 382IPC of SR Nagar PS and remanded him to judicial custody. The preventive detention order was executed on him on 19.1.2019 and was lodged him in Central Prison, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad.

PERSON FABRICATING FAKE EDUCATIONAL CERTIFICATES AND OTHER CERTIFICATES NABBED – SEIZED SEVERAL FAKE CERTIFICATES, TWO LAPTOPS, ONE MOBILE PHONE AND A COLOUR PRINTER .

On 27-01-2019, the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, South Zone Team, Hyderabad along with Narayanaguda Police apprehended a person by name George Kaseri, who is running a VISA consultancy and is involved in fabricating fake Marks Memos, University certificates, IT returns statement, Experience Certificates of MNCs etc and seized several fake Marks Memos, Educational certificates, two Laptops, One mobile phone and a Colour printer.

Brief History of accused persons:-

The accused is a native of Hyderabad. He completed his schooling and Intermediate in Open school. After completing Intermediate, he joined as a faculty of accounting in MAC Infotech and worked there for seven years. As his salary was meagre, he stopped working there. To have better future, he joined in Medical coding course. After completion of above course, he worked as a Medical coder for eighteen months. As the work was hectic with little salary and no further prospects in future, he quit the above job and stayed at home without any work for two years.

During the above period, he gained knowledge about Consultancy services through Internet and also gained knowledge about the payments the Consultancies charge for students who go abroad for studying. After gaining knowledge in the above field, he got in touch with Canada College at Montreal, MLC Business Technology College, Ontario which offers several Diploma courses in Business Admin and Commerce, Data base Technology, Early childhood programme and started working for those colleges as International student recruiter and started a consultancy at his residence.

George selected above colleges as there is no need for a student to appear/qualify in IELTS or PTE tests, which are obligatory for students who want to pursue higher studies abroad. As the above colleges offer only Diploma courses there is no need for the above two tests. He never reveals to the students that the courses offered by above colleges are Diploma courses and keeps them under impression that they are going to pursue higher studies abroad in some reputed colleges and charges them heavily towards consultancy charges.

In the process of obtaining VISA and admission, he collects the scanned copies of Educational certificates, Passport and other relevant documents from the students who approach him. In the process of obtaining VISA if a student has any shortcomings i.e; gap during educational curriculum, below 60% marks in Intermediate and Degree, gap after Degree course etc, he overcomes such shortcomings by fabricating documents.

In case of a student who has gap in his educational curriculum, he fabricates new educational certificates in consecutive years and overcomes the gap period and fulfils the requirement of above colleges. If a student has aggregate marks below 60% in Intermediate and Degree he fabricates new Marks memos. For a student who has a gap of two years in between the date of completion of Degree course and the date of seeking admission in above colleges, he fabricates experience certificates of bogus companies. He charges separately from students for these services.

After completion of due procedure of admission, if the student gets Letter of Acceptancy from above colleges, Kaseri fabricates IT returns in the name of the student's family members.

Through above means, the accused George Kaseri has cheated students on the name of seeking them admission into higher courses by suppressing the real fact that the courses offered in above colleges are Diploma courses and also fabricating fake documents to run his business and making easy money and exploiting innocent students for his selfish needs.
