

PD ACT INVOKED AGAINST MOHAMMED FAISAL SHAH ALI @ JABRI @ MASOOD AHMED KHAN @ ABDULLAH @ SOHAIL @ ALTAF S/O LATE MOHAMMED IBRAHIM @ SAYEED AHMED KHAN, SNATCHER OF SULTAN BAZAR POLICE STATION, EAST ZONE, HYDERABAD

Sri Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City invoked P.D.Act against Mohammed Faisal Shah Ali @ Jabri @ Masood Ahmed Khan @ Abdullah @ Sohail @ Altaf S/o Late Mohammed Ibrahim @ Sayeed Ahmed Khan, Snatcher of Sultan Bazar Police Station on 28-8-2018.

Mohammed Faisal Shah Ali @ Jabri S/o Late Mohammed Ibrahim @ Sayeed Ahmed Khan, aged about 38 years, Un-employee, R/o H.No. 12-1-556/1, Murad Nagar, Asif Nagar, opposite to Asif Nagar PS, Hyderabad, has been indulging in a series of property offences by committing robberies, snatching and two wheeler vehicle thefts in the limits of Hyderabad and Cyberabad Police Commissionerates, to make easy money and lead a lavish life.

After his release from jail he again committed **9 offences** in the limits of Hyderabad and Cyberabad Police Commissionerates and has been creating large scale fear and panic among the general public by committing robberies, snatching and two wheeler vehicle thefts, thereby adversely effecting the public order, apart from disturbing the peace, tranquillity and social harmony in the society.

Sultan Bazar Police made strenuous efforts and arrested Mohammed Faisal Shah Ali @ Jabri, on 23.3.2018 in Cr. No 37/2018 U/s 394, 420 IPC and Sec 27 of Arms Act, 1959 of Sultan Bazar PS and was remanded to judicial custody. The Preventive Detention order was executed on him on **29.8.2018** and was lodged in Central Prison, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad.

TWO HELD – WHO CHEATED THE INNOCENT PEOPLE IN THE GUISE OF PROVIDING MEDICAL SEATS IN BANGALORE BY COLLECTING HUGE MONEY – RECOVERED NET CASH OF RS.24,96,250/- FROM THEIR POSSESSION

The sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone team apprehended (2) accused persons by name 1) Abhimanyu Kumar Singh @ Dinesh Kumar Singh @ Arnav Kumar Singh and 2) SuryanarayanaJha @ Deepak @ Rishikanth @ Chandra Prakash who cheated innocent people under the guise of providing Medical college seats in medical colleges at Bangalore by taking huge money from them. Recovered **net cash of Rs.24,96,250/-, Visiting Cards, Cell Phones and other incriminating documents** from their possession.

Details of Accused:-

1) Abhimanyu Kumar Singh @ Dinesh Kumar Singh @ Arnav Kumar Singh S/o Vijay Pratap Singh, aged 35 yrs, Occ: Medicine Business, R/o Marhaura(V), Chapra (M), Saran District, Bihar.

2)SuryanarayanaJha @ Deepak @ Rishikanth @ Chandra Prakash S/o Late BalichandJha, aged 30 yrs, Occ: Medical Representative, R/o 39, Benta Nepali Camp, DMC Campus, Lehariyasarai, Darbhanga District, Bihar.

3) Kamran Hussain @ ShashankShekhar @ Abhinav Kishore R/o Patna, Bihar – **Absconding.**

4) Asgar Sayeed @ Abhay, R/o Patna, Bihar – **Absconding.**

Brief History of Accused:-

The accused Abhimanyu Kumar Singh @ Dinesh Kumar Sijngh @ Arnav Kumar Singh is native of Marhaura(V), Chapra (M), Saran District, Bihar state. He studied upto B.Tech(CSE) at Pune. His father was a Medical officer at DMCH (Darbhanga Medical College and Hospital), Darbhanga, Bihar and his mother is housewife. At present the accused is doing Medicine transport business at Bihar.

The accused SuryanarayanaJha @ Deepak @ Rishikanth @ Chandra Prakash is native of Benta Nepali Camp, DMC Campus, Lehariyasarai, Darbhanga District, Bihar state. He studied upto Intermediate at Darbanga, Bihar. His father was a govt. employee and his mother is housewife. At the present the accused is working as Medical Representative at MP Health Care, Darbanga, Bihar.

The accused persons Abhimanyu Kumar Singh and SuryanarayanaJha are childhood friends. The other accused Kamran Hussain and Asgar Sayeed @ Abhay are also became friends of Abhimanyu Kumar Singh from last 3 years.

Modus operandi:-

About three years back the accused Abhimanyu Kumar Singh came into contact with the accused Kamran Hussain at Patna and they both developed friendship with each other. Due to financial problems both hatched a plan to cheat the innocent needy persons under the guise of providing Medical college seats at Bangalore Colleges by taking huge money from them.

The accused persons Abhimanyu Kumar Singh and Kamran Hussain collected the data of students who qualified in NEET Exams. Later they called

them on telephone and informed them that they would arrange medical college seats on commission basis. Basing on their words the innocent persons approached them for arrange of medical in colleges on commission basis. In this manner they have collected huge money from them but they did not arrange any seats for them in any college and there by cheated the innocent parents.

Later in the month of April-2017 the both accused persons opened a consultancy office on the name of "SKY BRIDGE INFOTECH CONSULTANTS" at Flat No.207, 2nd Floor, Maheshwari Chambers, Somajiguda, Hyderabad with fake names.

At the time of taking rent of Flat No.207, Maheshwari Chambers the accused persons submitted fake ID proofs to the owner of flat.

The accused persons offered innocent people that they will arrange medical seats for them in any Medical Colleges at Bangalore as per the availability of seats. They offered Rs.60 to Rs.80 Lakhs per each seat including their commission. They collected Rs.48 Lakhs from the 18 customers and absconded by closing the office. Later the victims approached the management of Medical colleges at Bangalore, they came to know that they were cheated by the accused persons. Victims returned to Hyderabad and lodged complaints at Panjagutta Police Station.

In the month of May-2018 the accused persons went to Bhopal and opened a consultancy office on the name of "ASCENT" (positively different) at Office No.119, 1st Floor, ChinarIncube Business Center, Chinar Fortune City, Hoshangabad Road, Bhopal by changing their names as Abhimanyu Kumar Singh as Arnav Kumar Singh, Kamran Hussain as Abhinav Kishore, SuryanarayanaJha as Chandra Prakash. and cheated the innocent needy persons in the same manner by collecting of Rs.40 Lakhs from them.

In this case the absconding accused persons Kamran Hussain and Asgar Sayeed are yet to be apprehended. Efforts are continued to trace out the absconding accused persons.

On a tip off, the West Zone Task Force team apprehended the accused and recovered the above said property from their possession. The accused persons along with recovered property were being handed over to SHO, Panjagutta PS, Hyderabad for taking further necessary action.

The following Traffic Advisory is being issued for all routes and places in and around Hyderabad City and would apply from 10:00 AM to 12:00 Midnight on 02-09-2018 (Sunday) for the purpose of smooth public movement especially to the vehicles moving along the Outer Ring Road (ORR) and the adjoining service roads.

ADVISORY TO GENERAL PUBLIC

1. General Public travelling to /from Airport, Railway Stations and Bus Stands are advised to plan their journey keeping in view the likely movement of people attending meeting in and around the city of Hyderabad. For any Enquiry / Help a Traffic Control Room at Adibatla P.S. is setup with Helpline No.s. **9493 549 410 / 9493 549 411**.
2. Please avoid movement on ORR and the adjoining service roads between 10:00 AM to Midnight on 02-09-2018. All Emergency services / Ambulances will be given priority and commuters are requested to co-operate in the free movement of such vehicles.
3. Drivers of heavy Goods vehicles are advised not to use ORR on 02-09-2018 from 10:00AM to 12:00 midnight. They are advised to take alternative routes and take guidance of police officers posted at such places.
4. Heavy traffic movement is likely along the following roads:
 - a. Kukatpally- Miyapur- Hafeezpet- Gachibowli – ORR Route.
 - b. Uppal- Nagole- L.B Nagar- Sagar Road.
 - c. Private bus operators intending to proceed towards Vijayawada and Bangalore are requested to plan their departure from Hyderabad as there may be heavy traffic movement along these roads from 8 PM (02-09-2018) to 1 AM (03-09-2018).
 - d. Movement along all the National / State High ways leading **to** Hyderabad is likely to be more on 02-09-2018 morning 08:00 AM to evening 06:00 PM. Similarly movement **from** Hyderabad along all National / State High Ways is likely to be more on 02-09-2018 evening 07:00 PM to 03-09-2018 early morning hours (upto 05:00AM). General Public travelling to / from Hyderabad by road are requested to plan their travel accordingly.
5. Several police officers have been deployed at all important places to guide public for free movement during the period to avoid any inconvenience.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONSTO PARTICIPANTS OF PUBLIC MEETING.

- ❖ **Participants arriving to attend meeting on Tractors are advised to come in advance on 01-09-2018 evening hours only and they should leave venue on 03-09-2018 morning hours only.**
- ❖ Slow moving vehicles are prohibited on ORR. Autos, Two wheelers, Tractors are prohibited on ORR. Cars, Lorries, and Buses are permitted.
- ❖ All parking places are located close to the public meeting venue. Vehicles reaching the venue should strictly take the designated route and park their vehicles at designated parking places. All parking places are numbered and participants are requested to make a note of it. Participants of the meeting will have to walk from the parking area to meeting venue.

PRESS NOTE

Cyber Crime Police of CCS, Detective Department, Hyderabad, apprehended (2) two offenders namely 1) Mr. Rabiul Sepai S/o Golam Sepai, Age: 28 Yrs, Occ: Pvt Employee, R/o Uttar Kalyanpur, PS Baruipur, South 24 PGS, West Bengal, 2) Mr. Anarul Molla S/o Late Eliyas Molla, Age: 26yrs, Occ: Business, R/o Surjyapur (vil&Po), PS Baruipur, South 24 PGS, West Bengal, who are assisting inter-state fraudsters by providing their bank accounts on commission basis. The gang are indulging in obtaining debit/credit card details from bank customers by posing themselves as executives/officials of banks, call the customers, lure them informing that their ATM cards and bank accounts are blocked/to be linked with Aadhaar card, and for unblocking ATM cards/bank accounts, they require details of debit/credit cards and collect card number, cvv number, expiry date and OTP numbers and fraudulently transfer the money in to e-commerce wallets and from there they will transfer the fraudulent amount in to various bank accounts. Police seized (2) Mobile Phones, (2) debit cards, (1) bank account pass book from the possession of accused.

FACTS OF THE CASE:

Basing on the complaint received from Sri T. Malkappa S/o late Ashappa, age 69 yrs, Occ; Retd.employee, R/o H.No.1-6-212/65/107/132, Gangaputra Colony, Musheerabad, Hyderabad. regarding receiving call from unknown person posing as Bank Official who obtained his SBI debit card details and OTP numbers fraudulently and made on line transactions for Rs.69,994/- on 27-05-2018, a case was registered vide Cr.No. 156/2018, U/Sec. 66 (C) (D) I.T.A Act 2008, Sec.419, 420 IPC at Cyber Crime PS, CCS, Hyderabad and investigated into.

During the course of investigation, basing on the information provided by banks and e-commerce wallets and clues on hand, police teams lead by Sri D. Prashanth, Sub-Inspector of Police, Cyber Crime PS, CCS, Hyderabad, proceeded to West Bengal and apprehended the accused persons. They were brought to Hyderabad on transit remand and are being remanded to judicial custody.

Details of the arrested persons :-

- A2) Mr. Anarul Molla S/o Late Eliyas Molla, Age: 26yrs, Occ: Business, R/o Surjyapur (vil&Po), PS Baruipur, South 24 PGS, West Bengal.

M.O. OF THE OFFENDER:-

The Accused persons and their associates hailing from West Bengal and Jharkhand states are assisting inter-state fraudsters indulging in obtaining debit/credit card details including OTP numbers from bank customers posing themselves as bank officials by providing them bank accounts on commission basis.

The teams headed by Sri D. Prashanth, Sub-Inspector of Police along with staff under the supervision of Sri KCS Raghu Vir, Addl. Dy. Commissioner of Police, Cyber Crime PS, Hyderabad, apprehended the accused persons.

LAKE POLICE RESCUED THREE PERSONS FROM COMMITTING SUICIDE

On 30th & 31st of August 2018, P S Lake officials has rescued **Three persons** in different timing and situation i.e., One male & two female. Were all rescued, while they were about to commit suicide by jumping into the Hussain Sagar Lake. The Details of the victims are as follows:-

First incident: Occurred on 30/08/2018 at 2230 hours jumped into water beside upper tankbund out post immediately patrolling Lake police noticed him and saved his life, shifted him to Lake P.S.

Details of Victim: one man, age:- 39 yrs, r/o:- Nagpur, maharashtra.

Reason: On enquiry it came to know that he is mentally unsound and dumb, look like a beggar. He unable to tell any details of him. Hence he was handed over to ANAND ASHRAM - Rehabilitation centre, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad at Prisons Department Telangana state.

Second incident: It occurred on 31/08/2018 at around 0915 hours upper tankbund at Pooja stal.

Details of Victim:- one women, age:- 20yrs, occ:- daily labour, r/o:- narayanguda, hyd.

Reason: On enquiry victim revealed that she is a married person and leading conjugal life happily. Since their marriage her husband started suspecting her character and quarrels daily, she also said that husband is an alcoholic. As usually last night he went to home in a fully drunken condition and started quarrelling with the victim and bet her black and blue. She unable to bare the torture and decided to end her life and came. I counselled her promptly, after that send to Bharosa centre for further action.

Third incident: It occurred on 31/08/2018 at around 1130 hours upper tankbund near Kanukuri veereshalingam statue.

Details of Victim:- one women, age:- 30 yrs, occ:- pvt employee, r/o:- nizampet, R.R. dist.

Reason: on enquiry victim revealed that she is a married person and blessed with one daughter. Five years her husband passed away due to some health problem, since then victim and her daughter staying at her maternal house. Today in the morning hour's victim and her daughter quarrelled with each other in a petty family issue. Due to which she went into depression and came to tankbund. I counselled her promptly, after counselling send to Bharosa centre for further action.

As such Lake Police played a vital role in saving them spontaneously without giving any scope for untoward incidents for which they could save the lives of people. These three incidents were occurred on 30/31-04-2018. I counselled them promptly and they were safely handed over to their relatives and concerned by taking their assurances that they will not repeat such things in near & future.

Thus, the patrolling Blue Colts of Lake PS viz., HC 7622, Bhaskar reddy, HG 5348 – P. Subba reddy, have tactfully identified the above persons in a suspicious manner and rescued them from committing suicide.
