**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 21 (1) (b) of the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli, I. ANJANI KUMAR, IPS., Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, do hereby notify, for information of the general public that, in order to facilitate proper control and regulation of traffic, in view of the All India Industrial Exhibition to be held at the Exhibition Grounds, Nampally, Hyderabad, the following traffic restrictions are imposed between 01.01.2019 to 15.02.2019 from 1600 hours upto midnight till the completion of the Exhibition.

1. RTC District Buses, Private Buses and Heavy Vehicles coming from SA bazaar, and Jambagh side intending to go towards Nampally side will be diverted at MJ Market towards Abids.
2. RTC District Buses, Private Buses, and Heavy Vehicles coming from Police Control Room & Basheer Bagh intending to go towards Nampally will be diverted at AR Petrol Pump and BJR Statue towards Abids.
3. The Heavy and Light Goods Vehicles coming from Begum Bazar Chatri and intending to go towards Malakunta will be diverted at the Alaska junction towards Darusalam and Ek minar, Nampally.
4. The Heavy and Light Goods Vehicles (DCM's) coming from Darusalam (Goshamahal Road) intending to go towards Afzalgunj or Abids will be diverted at Alaska towards Begum Bazar, City College, Nayapool.
5. The Heavy and Light Goods Vehicles including RTC busses coming from Moosa Bowli / Bhadurpura side intending to go towards Nampally will be diverted at City College towards Nayapool & MJ Market.

In view of All India Industrial Exhibition, the general public is suggested to take alternative routes and avail the **public Transport System like RTC Buses and Metro Rail Services** to avoid traffic jams and parking problem and co-operate with the Police Personnel on duty.

### **BRIEF NOTE ON THE BABY GIRL**

On 30-12-2018 at about 2330 hrs one person by name Md. Irfan R/o: Yakuthpura, Hyderabad brought one baby girl age about (02) two months and stated that at about 2130 hrs., while he was standing near Osmania General Hospital, one Muslim lady who was in a drunken condition came near to him and handed over her baby by saying that she would come back within few minutes as she wanted water, but she didn't return back. As the baby was crying incessantly, he didn't know what to do, then he went to his residence at Yakuthpura, Hyderabad along with the baby girl and tried to feed her with sachet milk, but he could not succeed to feed. Under the situation, he along with his friends and relatives came to Afzalgunj P.S. at around 2330 hrs., and handed over the baby. Sri M. Ravinder the E-cops PC 2821 who was on the night duty in the PS had noticed that the baby was crying for milk and he informed the same to his wife Smt. Priyanka, who works as a Woman Police Constable with G.No.5538 at Woman Police Station Begumpet, Hyderabad through mobile phone. On the request of her husband, she came to P.S. Afzalgunj by engaging a cab. She feed the baby girl and after that she left to her residence. Smt. Priyanka is on Maternity leave.

The police later made efforts to identity the mother of the baby, but couldn't trace. Subsequently, the baby was shifted to the Govt. Maternity Hospital, Petlaburz, Hyderabad.

Today i.e. 31-12-2018 at about 0830 hrs during the search efforts of ASI Sri Md. Taheruddin came to known that one Muslim lady was found crying at Chanchalguda for her lost baby. He rushed to her and brought her to the police station and caused enquiries. She stated that her name is Shabana Begum w/o Feroz Khan, Age: 30 Yrs, Occ: Ragpicker, R/o Khadri Chaman Dargah, Falaknuma, Hyderabad. She has 2 daughters namely Samreen Begum, Age: 05 Yrs and Fathiana Begum Age: 02 months. Yesterday night she had given her younger baby Fathiana Begum to one person at OGH by saying to bring water, but she forgot the place where she left her baby due to her drunken condition. She is addicted to drink toddy. She is the wife of Mr. Feroz Khan, who is an property offender and he is also addicted consuming alcohol and whitener and he was arrested by PS Afzalgunj in Cr. No: 416/2018 U/s 379 IPC (Cell Phone Theft) on 10-12-2018.

She has been brought to the Maternity hospital and shown the baby. The baby girl has been identified by the mother. After verification of the interrogation report of Feroz Khan( the father of the baby) and confirmation about the family details, the baby was handed over to the mother.

The work done by Smt K. Priyanka, 2014 batch WPC-5538 of Begumpet, Hyderabad as a mother and a Police Officer is highly appreciable and the timely action of Sri M. Ravinder, 2010 batch PC 2821 of PS Afzalgunj, Hyderabad is appreciable. The act of this power couple has reiterated the commitment of the power in the service if the community. This has brought an year end cheer among the public of Hyderabad city for the hard work and dedication to duty all throughout the year. On this occasion I congratulate all the police officers of Hyderabad City police and also all the spouses of police officers for enabling them to perform better despite the sacrifice of personal and family time in the performance of duties.

**TRAFFIC ADVISORY**

In view of swearing-in-ceremony of Shri Justice Thottathil B. Radhakrishnan as Hon'ble Chief Justice of High Court for the State of Telangana at Raj Bhavan, Hyderabad on 01-01-2019 at 0830 hrs, the Raj Bhavan road from Monappa Island (Rajiv Gandhi Statue) to V.V. Statue Junction will witness heavy traffic. The traffic congestion is expected from 0730 hrs to 0930 hrs. On need basis, the traffic will be diverted or stopped at Monappa Island and VV Statue Junction. Panjagutta – Raj Bhavan Quarters Road (Metro Residency) will be closed for general traffic on both sides during this period.

**Following places are earmarked for parking of vehicles at Raj Bhavan :**

1. **Gate No-III to Administrative Block :** Hon'ble Judges, MsP., MsLA and MsLC Vehicles.
2. **Dilkusha Guest House:** Media Vehicles
3. **MMTS Parking lot:** Other VIP Vehicles & Government dignitaries vehicles

**NABBED DRUG PEDDLERS - SEIZED (89) GRAMS OF COCAINE BY WEST ZONE TASK FORCE**

On 31-12-2018, the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone Team apprehended (2) accused persons who were found in possession of Narcotic substance/Drug i.e. Cocaine in order to deliver the same to needy customers at Film Nagar, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad. **Seized (89) grams of Cocaine and (3) Cell phones** from their possession.

**Details of Accused persons:**

1. Livio Joseph Almeida @ Piyush S/o Late Jeronimo Baptista Almeida, aged 34 yrs, Occ: Vehicles rent business at Calangute, Goa, R/o H.No.125, Fatta Waddo Nerul, Bardez, Goa.
2. U.Shankar S/o U.Suryanarayana, aged 41 yrs, Occ: Wall painter, R/o H.No.8-2-269/19/669/2, Road No.2, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad, N/o Tanuku, West Godavari, A.P.

**Brief about the accused persons:-**

The accused Livio Joseph Almeida is native of Fatta Waddo Nerul, Bardez, Goa state. About six years back his parents were expired. After expiry of his father he started doing vehicles rent business at Calangute, Goa by residing at above said address.

The accused U.Shankar is native of Tanuku of West Godavari, A.P. His father is working as accountant in Fruit market, Vijayawada. About twelve years back, he along with his wife and children came to Hyderabad for livelihood, started working as Wall painter by residing at the above said address.

**Modus Operandi:**

The accused Livio Joseph Almeida @ Piyush is residing at Fatta Waddo Nerul, Bardez, Goa and doing vehicles rent business at Calangute and also working as Cab driver at Goa. But his earnings are not sufficient to meet his lavish expenses. At the same time, in Goa he observed that some of the Nigerian nationals are purchasing Cocaine from unknown persons on lowest price and selling the same to needy customers on higher price and getting profits for their lavish expenses. As such he also hatched a plan to purchase Cocaine drug from Nigerians and sell the same to the needy customers at Goa and started purchasing Cocaine drug for Rs.3,000/- per 1 gram from Nigerians at Goa and selling the same for Rs.6,000/- to Rs.7,000/- per 1 grams in Goa.

About eight months back he came into contact with the accused U.Shankar at Goa and developed friendship with him. The accused Livio Joseph Almeida @ Piyush informed the accused U.Shankar that he is selling Cocaine in Hyderabad and asked to assist him in selling of Cocaine in Hyderabad and agreed to pay some amount as commission. For which the accused U.Shankar agreed to assist him in selling of Cocaine in Hyderabad.

As per the instructions of Livio Joseph Almeida @ Piyush, the accused U.Shankar is regularly going to Goa and collecting the Cocaine drug from him and delivering the same to the needy customers in Hyderabad and giving money to him by receiving from the customers. The accused Livio Joseph Almeida @ Piyush handing over the Cocaine drug to accused U.Shankar by packing 1 grams in a small polythene cover wrapped with plaster. Sometimes the accused Livio Joseph Almeida @ Piyush used to come to Hyderabad to deliver the Cocaine drug to accused U.Shankar for Rs.7,000/- per 1 gram. The accused Shankar is selling 1 gram Cocaine for Rs.11,000/-.

Today i.e. on 31-12-2018 the accused Livio Joseph Almeida @ Piyush came to Hyderabad and met the accused U.Shankar at Film Nagar, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad and while handing over the Cocaine drug, in the meantime West Zone Task Force team apprehended the accused persons along with Cocaine drug. The accused are being handed over to SHO, Banjarahills to SHO, Banjara Hills.

Further investigation is being conducted by SHO, Banjara Hills to unearth his network with other local and foreign drug dealers.

The arrests were made under the supervision of **Sri P.Radha Kishan Rao, Dy.Commissioner of Police**, Commissioner's Task Force, by **Sri B.Gattu Mallu**, Inspector of Police, Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone team, SIs Sri P.Mallikarjun, Sri B.Durga Rao, Sri Md.Mujaffar Ali and on the information of PC.9586 Sri G.Lokeshwar Rao of West Zone Team, Commissioner's Task Force, Hyderabad.

Saud Amoodi @ Saud @ Amoodi s/o Shaik Mahamood Amoodi, aged about 36 years, R/o H.No.8-2-418, Flat No.4, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Road No.4, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad has committed **offences of attempt to murder and criminal intimidation in public places in the limits of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate.**

The accused/detenu has committed 4 offences in the recent past under the limits of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate and has been creating large scale fear and panic among the general public, thereby adversely affecting the public order, apart from disturbing the peace, tranquillity and social harmony in the society.

Humayunnagar Police made sincere efforts and arrested the accused Saud Amoodi @ Saud @ Amoodi s/o Shaik Mahamood Amoodi on 29.5.2018 in Cr.No.8/2018 U/s 307, 120 (B) r/w 34 IPC, 27 Arms Act of Humayunnagar PS and remanded him to judicial custody. The Preventive Detention Order was executed on him on **27.11.2018** and he was lodged in Central Prison, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad.
